

SENDEMDOWNTHEROAD set the early pace racing slightly removed from the rail and weakened during the drive. GRAND FESTIVAL was forwardly placed while racing three-wide but lacked a rally when asked. SMACKOVER LIME raced in the middle of the field while four-wide and went evenly. LARRY'S LUNCHBOX broke out and steadied shortly after the start, then dropped back, came three-wide into the stretch and failed to menace. BLACK RUSSIAN saved ground while being unhurried and failed to seriously threaten. SAN RONIN was allowed to settle early, came four-wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
