NAGY AND DA BEARS led the way on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and held the win to the wire. MR. SWEETS stalked the pace setter on the outside through the opening quarter, navigated the turn from the three path and gained ground late. PONCHO ATTACK bumped with the horse his inside at the start, settled off the pace on the outside for the run up the backstretch, came around the turn in the four path, brushed lightly with STORM'S REFLECTION at the top of the stretch and improved position from there. A P BLAZING GREEN raced in the middle of the pack early, saved ground around the turn and was outkicked in the lane. STORM'S REFLECTION bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, raced off the pace on the rail through the opening stages, came around the turn in the two and three path, brushed mildly with PONCHO ATTACK entering the stretch and showed no kick. RODAVLAS pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the bend in the two path and faded in the stretch.
