CIAO TOMMASO rated to the inside of a rival while stalking an embattled trio, shifted out when afforded a clear path three wide into the lane, hopped over to the left lead while clear near mid stretch, got back onto his correct lead near the sixteenth marker and drew out while kept to task. STORMY ATTACK vied between foes, moved to a slim lead leaving the far turn, clung to the advantage nearing the lane, failed to contain the winner's outer bid past the three sixteenths, faded but was able to save the place. JAKES CHANNEL was squeezed back soon after the break, recovered to chase outside the winner, came three wide for the drive but failed to muster up a solid run. CHIEF GROSS edged up between horses soon after the break, dropped in to secure the inside and a short lead, vied inside a pair of rivals around the turn, continued with effort to about mid stretch then weakened. CITIZEN EX , three deep forcing the pace, drifted out a path entering the stretch, corrected to chase on to mid stretch, hopped over to the left lead near the sixteenth pole and weakened. GOOD YEGG broke slowly, sustained an injury while racing on the far turn, was pulled up then euthanized on the course. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
