TWIRLING ROSES settled off the pace while saving ground, responded when cued leaving the three eighths, eased out and progressed three wide and to the inside of a rival near the quarter pole, powered past an inner ALL ABOUT TONITE in upper stretch and pulled away under an energetic hand ride. ALL ABOUT TONITE sped clear early, set a rated pace towards the inside, was shaken up soon into the lane, was unable to contain the winner's outer bid but stayed on willingly to be clear of the rest. MON AMI FUZZIE drifted out at the break, corrected and raced off the pace while coaxed along, saved ground into the lane, was guided outward for the final sixteenth and finished with interest. LATIN CASINO, bumped at the break, regrouped and moved up outside rivals to gain a stalking spot, circled four wide with pursuit into the stretch, failed to go on past the three sixteenths and weakened. HIGHLY PERFECT was urged between foes early but was unable to keep pace. CANYON SHADOWS came out soon after the break bumping with a rival, steadied then dropped well off the pace, entered the stretch about four wide and failed to get involved.
