SHARP ATTACK vied inside a pair of rivals into the turn, shook clear under a light hold mid turn, opened up two wide and under asking in upper stretch, was kept alert with repeated right handed asks and held sway. ORNERLY ANGEL , off the pace and off the inside under a ride, circled five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. BETHY , a bit reluctant to load, came away forwardly then drafted back to stalk the embattled trio of early leaders, was under coaxing mid turn, raced four wide and to the inside of ORNERLY ANGEL into the stretch and churned on to nab the show. MISS SAIPAN , three deep vying into the turn, pressed outside the winner soon after, gave willing chase from the quarter pole to deep stretch then faded. LOST SUNSET broke through the gate when fractious pre race but did not get away while under the deft handling of the assistant starter, examined and reloaded, disputed the early pace between runners, checked leaving the far turn, regrouped to pursue towards the inner rail, failed to kick on in upper stretch and gave way.
