ONE TIMER seized command at once, remained clear on the turn and pulled further away under token pressure. SHAKE UP raced forwardly along the inside, kept on well in the stretch but was no match. MR. SWEETS raced forwardly while three wide, remained three wide throughout and kept on in the stretch. NAGY AND DA BEARS saved ground, was angled three wide into the stretch and did not menace. GUNNY SACK lunged at the start costing him early position, went five wide into the stretch and offered no bid. PONCHO ATTACK chased while four wide, briefly advanced on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. STORM'S REFLECTION reserved early, moved five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally.
