SPINNING GLORY sprinted away from her rivals in the initial furlong, held well into the stretch, responded to steady pressure and remained clear. FRANKEL BABY raced in striking position while three wide, lodged a bid on the turn and finished well. FLORIBUNDA forwardly placed, was angled in for the stretch run and stayed on while racing along the inside fence. APRIL'S GEM fractious in the starting gate beforehand, was outrun early and showed some mild late interest while racing along the rail in the stretch. FONDRE saved ground, was angled three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. DEAL'EM AND WEEP off slowly, advanced briefly on the turn and came up empty in the stretch.
