SECOND OPINION raced up the inside shortly from the break to take command, set the pace on a clear, well measured lead to the top of the lane, repelled the bid of the runner-up in mid-stretch and kicked away in the final sixteenth. TUMMYCAT stalked the pace to midway on the turn, rallied to threaten in upper stretch, was turned away by the winner and finished willingly as second best. RAPID tracked the leaders to the head of the lane to be prominently placed and lacked a closing kick in the stretch. SPORTLOTO reserved off the pace to the bend, rallied four wide closing the gap on the turn, was fanned eight wide turning for home and flattened out in the lane. PHINAROSA flashed brief speed to set the early pace, pressed to midway on the turn and faded from contention. CITRA TIME broke awkwardly to drop to the rear giving the field several lengths away from the gate and was never a factor from there.
