CLOEY ATTACK stalked the pace for the first half mile, rallied to the lead on the final turn, quickly went clear in upper stretch and held well a convincing winner. ZEE reserved off the pace to midway on the far turn, circled six wide with a steady gain and was up for the place in final sixteenth. PEACOCK ROAD slow early to be at the rear of the field, rallied well turning for home to be chasing the winner at the head of the pack down the lane and flattened out in the late going unable to sustain the bid. KEEN GAL tracked the leaders for the first three-quarters to be well placed turning for home and lacked a closing kick for the drive. MY LADY SLEW set the pace under mild pressure for a half and gave way when challenged on the far turn. END OF INNOCENCE was not a threat going evenly. WEDNESDAY ADDAMS pressed the pace from the inside for the first three-eighths, steadied along the fence when in tight nearing the half mile pole, steadily faded to the rear and it was determined post-race that she had bled, walking off the track under her own power.
