MARY MOONGLOW prompted the pace down the backstretch, vied for the lead on the turn, responded well when called upon turning for home and pulled away in the lane convincingly. MISTY SUNDAY stalked the leaders to the turn, dueled on the bend taking the lead briefly from four wide, could not match the winner in the final eighth and kept-on willingly to hold the place. LONG TALL WOMAN reserved off the pace to the quarter pole, circled six wide coming for home and showed good interest to be along for the show. LUNARCHY hustled away from the gate to be with the early lead, settled to track the leaders into the turn and rallied with a mild bid down the stretch. HEAVENLY HASH raced up the inside flashing early speed to set the pace and faded when confronted early on the turn. COCKTAIL CUTIE was reluctant to load and raced with the same enthusiasm trailing throughout.
