MCMONEY settled off the pace four five wide down the back stretch, upped the tempo five wide around the second bend, long sustained drive, shook free leaving the sixteenth marker, drew away through the wire. FLYING SAMURAI broke sharp, set a solo pace inside into the far turn, collared around the furlong marker, chased on well to secure the place. NEW YEAR SURPRISE rated inside off the pace into the far turn, quickened to bid along the rail leaving the quarter pole, unable to work out of the inside pocket, chased on one paced through the final sixteenth. CONTRABANDISTA slow into stride, saved ground off the pace around the far turn, never fired through the stretch. BLURT stalked the leader around the first turn, put to task three deep leaving the quarter pole, faded through the final sixteenth. ICE AXE settled into stride four wide and off the pace for the run into the far turn, under pressure approaching the furlong marker, weakened through the wire.
