GUNNY SACK rated the pace into the turn, quickly angled off the rail three deep leaving the quarter pole, relentless rally outside rival through the final sixteenth, up under the wire. WINGS OF GOD settled off the pace into the turn, angled inside approaching the furlong marker, chased gamely inside foe through the wire. BOURBON STREET BOY broke very sharp, sprinted to a clear lead around the turn, collared by rivals leaving the furlong marker, stayed on evenly for the show money. MONEY AGENT slow to stride, circled the field five wide into the lane, under pressure outside through the final sixteenth, flattened out. A P BLAZING GREEN clean start, chased inside around the turn, gave way through the lane. FREEDOM EMPIRE roused off the pace between runners around the turn, weakened through the stretch. SMOOTH ATTACK chased the pace three wide around the turn, faltered through the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
