UNION DOLLY raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two and three path, began a bid passing the quarter pole and gained ground late to get up for the win. FROSTED ECLAIR tracked the leader on the outside early, navigated the bend from the two path and improved position on the rail in the lane. MORE THAN A DIVA led the way up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and was caught in late stretch. APRIL'S GEM chased the leaders on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and kept on to the wire. HARPER BRIANA raced in the middle of the pack between horses through the opening quarter, came around the turn in the two path and finished evenly. CHROME ATTACK raced off the pace on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and was empty from there. TIZMEONEMORETIME raced off the pace on the outside through the opening stages, angled in to save ground around the turn and made no bid. MAMBA OUT hopped up leaving the gate, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two and three path and faded in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
