FINDAWAY shared the command inside of CHAMPAGNE MIKE to the turn then edged away on the turn and drew off in the stretch to be ridden out. CHAMPAGNE MIKE was bumped at the start then moved up to share the command outside of FINDAWAY to the turn then fell back slightly but made a late rebid and was clearly second best. GABAGOOL raced near the back in the early stages then swung out to four wide going into the turn to improve position but flattened out. LINE TO GAIN trailed the field around the turn then made a mild rail bid to pass tiring rivals. I'M YOUR CAPTAIN stalked the pace from three wide through the turn but had no late kick and was not a factor. CAN MAN DO broke inward and bumped with rival at the start then tracked the leaders while saving ground but failed to menace.
