IDEA MAN tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend, switched outside to began a bid in upper stretch and edged clear. BREAKING NEWS chased the leaders on the outside through the opening quarter, challenged from the two path coming around the bend, dug in gamely in the lane and was caught late. OFF TO THE RACES was away from the gate slowly, raced off the pace up the backstretch, swung out to the four path to began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. KING OF THE PALACE settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two and three path and chased on in the lane but never truly threatened. RISKY BOY led the way on the inside up the backstretch, dueled while saving ground around the turn and weakened in the final furlong. SOMNUS raced in the middle of the pack on the inside early, dropped back to trail the field while saving ground around the bend and made no bid.
