COMMISSIONER OSCAR rated off the pace mid-pack into the far turn, steered out four wide leaving the quarter pole, found best strides late, kicked clear with good energy through the wire. SILVER QUARTERS rated well back into the far turn, quickened the pace three wide approaching the quarter pole, strong late rally, bested the rest. TEMPER TANTRUM very slow into stride, raced off the pace into the far turn, fully extended four deep through the lane, surged late for the show money. CLIFF DIVER stalked the dueling leaders into the far turn, stymied in traffic at the quarter pole, forged on inside through the final sixteenth, evened out to the wire. TEST PILOT away in good order, vied then dueled inside into the far turn, under pressure from outside foes leaving the furlong marker, gave way to the wire. VITALE saved ground mid-pack, bid two wide through the lane, weakened. CAT ATTACK broke very sharp, vied then dueled two wide into the far turn, faltered through the lane. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time available.
