NEON DEION, five deep in touch with the early pace, drafted back a bit and was guided towards the inner rail entering the turn, edged up between runners into the lane, eased out with momentum past the three sixteenths, closed in under pressure, forged to command in deep stretch then edged clear under a drive. RACARINO was taken back off the early scrum, angled out mid turn, edged up three wide past the three sixteenths, was guided further out for the final furlong then finished with good energy to just nab the place. FINDAWAY moved up two wide between runners to join the pace fray after a furlong, shook clear of foes leaving the far turn and set a rated pace, spurted away under asking leaving the three sixteenths, failed to deny the outer winner inside the sixteenth pole, gave way grudgingly and was nipped for second. SAND MOUNTAIN steadied back along the rail in the opening sixteenth, steadied when shuffled saving ground past the half, regrouped and remained inside entering the stretch, angled out through the drive and finished well. MON AMI FUZZIE drafted back off the pace, came three wide for the drive, worked between foes and got past faders. LATIN CASINO was sent up to the inside of a quartet of foes and contested the early pace, chased the leader around the turn then weakened in upper stretch. ALTO ROAD had speed to dispute the early pace three wide and between foes, chased three wide mid turn, wandered four wide into the stretch and weakened. GOOD SCOUT, with the early pace four wide and between runners, pursued four wide mid turn then dropped back in upper stretch.
