LADY HELENA seized the early advantage, led the way through moderate fractions, and held sway late from a mild threat under steady handling. DESSERT FIRST chased LADY HELENA from a couple of lengths back from the start, was slowly closing the gap in the final yards, but ran out of time. PASTA SALAD RHONDA settled at the back but never far back, saved ground throughout, and finished evenly to gain the third spot well behind the top pair. TALL GIRL got caught four-wide into the first turn, settled three-wide near the back down the backstretch, and lacked a finish. LILY'S CREED broke in and bumped HIDDEN SPIN at the start, tracked close up three-wide then came under the crop near the quarter pole and faltered. HIDDEN SPIN took a solid bump from LILY'S CREED at the start, then raced close up to the half-mile pole, then was pulled up, vetted, and walked on to the equine ambulance and transported from the course.
