STRANGE ARRANGE hopped slightly at the start, then took a light bump from the inside rival coming out of the gate, dueled with WINGING WAYS through the early stages, got the best of that one approaching the quarter pole, went clear by a couple of lengths when set down in upper stretch, then held safe to the wire. RUSSIAN TO WIN settled three-wide but not far from the front through the early stages, kept up a steady pace through the turn, then finished up well in the stretch to gain second but was not getting to the winner in the final furlong. NEON DEION broke outward at the start, making contact with STRANGE ARRANGE, kept to the inside without a clear path to the outside, steadied slightly near the seven-sixteenths marker, lost a bit of ground to the leaders through the turn, but put in a steady finish up the rail to gain the third prize. WINGING WAYS dueled with STRANGE ARRANGE to the turn, weakened leaving the five-sixteenths marker, then was outfinished in the stretch. UNCAPTURED PULSE was up close in the initial stages, steadied going into the turn, lost momentum and dropped to last, bid five-wide into the stretch but was unable to improve.
