WICKED SUPRISE was sent from the break with intent to get forward position, settled in a stalking position for the run down the backstretch, then pulled even under a drive approaching the quarter pole, took a slight lead in upper stretch, opened up a bit, then held clear to the wire. SLAVA UKRAINI raced close up through the first half-mile, then became boxed in through the far turn, then was still pinned in toward the rail in upper stretch, found some room late then finished up well to gain the place. MAN ON ATTACK pulled hard on the rider through the clubhouse turn to track just off the pace three-wide to the far turn, lugged in as the field turned for home, and was outfinished for second. CUTLASS KING got forward position early but was four-wide through the first turn, stayed that path and settled off the pace mid-pack through the early stages, came under a ride from the three-furlong pole and was left with a lot to do

from that point, jumped a track in mid-stretch, but was not doing enough. I O FEDRO was being hustled from the start but did not show any early speed, raced in the middle of the pack through the first half, produced a steady finish, jumped a track in mid-stretch, and finished evenly. CITY OF GOD lacked early speed, was coaxed a bit through the first turn to maintain contact with the field, moved up on the run to the far turn to be in striking position with about three furlongs to go, then was unable to keep up late. DINOS DIXIE hustled to the front from the start, led the way out of the first turn with several in immediate pursuit, maintained a slight lead to the far turn, fought back when challenged near the quarter pole, then weakened in upper stretch. PAW ALLEN got caught four-wide into the first turn, was being coaxed along going down the backstretch, then did not respond to urging in the stretch and never threatened. MARINARA SAUCED was not asked for speed from the break, settled at the rear of the field to the far turn, made a mild bid that went nowhere, and was unable to improve.
