GHOST COWBOY tracked the pace from the inside, was well placed to the backstretch run, angled three wide into the far turn and was set down for the drive, bid three wide into the lane and vied for the lead into the final furlong, took command in deep stretch and proved best under steady urging. TAP TO CONNECT was unhurried to the backstretch, roused outside of rivals along the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, could not reel in the winner in the final sixteenth but got up in time for second. SIPPIN SCOTCH hustled away from the start, vied for the early lead inside of RAROTONGA then dueled that runner to the backstretch, disputed the solid pace to the second turn, met oncoming bids into the stretch, yielded in the final sixteenth and just missed for second, while just holding for third. RAROTONGA was sent leaving the start, engaged with SIPPIN SCOTCH and dueled for pace duties outside of that rival heading into the backstretch, contested a solid pace to the quarter marker, vied between rivals into the stretch then battled to the final sixteenth, yielded in deep stretch and was outfinished for the minor awards. CRAZY RIDGE settled in the second flight leaving the start, got caught a bit in tight approaching the first turn and steadied off of heels nearing that bend, settled while saving ground to the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the quarter pole then did not rally in the lane. SLIM JIMMY settled in the second flight and outside of rivals, tracked the decent pace two to three wide to the half-mile pole, gave way into the far turn and lacked the needed late response.

SUPER BRADY vied for the early lead from inside of runners, took back approaching the turn, angled to the outside of rivals and re-bid four wide to the stretch, vied for the lead at the furlong pole then drew clear under steady urging in the late stages. MY WIFE IS RIGHT hustled away from the start, contested the early pace between runners then from the inside, took back into the turn, angled to the three path nearing the quarter marker and re-rallied between foes into the stretch, could not impact the winner in the final sixteenth but got up in time for the place. MO SATURDAYS vied for the early lead from outside of rivals, contested the pace four then three wide into the turn, led into the stretch, yielded in the final sixteenth, was outfinished late for second and was clear of the rest for third. CARBON STRYKER rated nicely off of the early pace while never far back, trailed into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch, needed more in the lane and passed tiring rivals late to improve position. FORT HOOD contested the early pace from between rivals, pressed from the inside heading into the turn, battled into upper stretch, could not keep pace past the furlong grounds and gave way. HAY SCOOBY DOO vied for the early lead four wide, pressed the pace three then two wide and between runners into the turn, was outrun into upper stretch and tired in the final furlong.

GRIND JIM allowed to settle in the early stages, roused at the three-eighths marker, bid three then four wide to upper stretch, rallied while on the left lead nearing the final sixteenth, took command in deep stretch and held safely at the wire for the win. CURLY'S ONE THING broke a step slowly, was sent to contest the early pace from between rivals, dueled from the inside into the turn, battled into upper stretch and took a narrow lead inside of the furlong pole, fought gamely to the final sixteenth, was outfinished in deep stretch and held safely late for second. FIFTYSHADESOFNAUTI hustled to contest the early pace, disputed the pace three wide along the backstretch, dueled outside of CURLY'S ONE THING into the turn then continued to battle that rival into upper stretch, yielded in the final sixteenth and held safely at the wire for third. ROMAN EAGLE rated off of the early pace, settled two wide to the turn, chased two wide to the quarter pole then ran in pursuit into the stretch, shifted to the rail and gained ground at the furlong pole, could not sustain his run to the final sixteenth and flattened out late. DRAMA KING was away in good order and vied for the early lead, took back along the backstretch run and saved ground into the turn, was well placed into the bend then lost ground nearing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. CHARLIE DONT SURF broke a bit slowly then rushed up in the early going, chased the leading pair while saving ground into the turn, was well placed nearing the quarter pole, could not muster the needed response nearing mid-stretch and gave way in the final stages. MADDIENLIZZYSHONOR allowed to settle in the early running, advanced while widest along the backstretch, roused four wide into the far turn, loomed to upper stretch then took command into the final furlong, drew clear to the final sixteenth and held sway to the wire. GOLD MAKIN GIRL unhurried in the early stages, saved ground to the far turn then waited for racing room at the quarter marker, swung five wide to upper stretch and weaved through rivals to the final sixteenth, was outkicked in deep stretch but got up in time for the place honors. FICKLE MISTRESS settled off of the early pace, tracked two wide and between rivals approaching the far turn, got caught in traffic at the quarter marker then found a seam along the rail to upper stretch, gave chase along the rail to the final sixteenth, could not find more late and just missed for second, while holding for third. REAL MISCHIEVOUS allowed to settle early on, tracked the pace three wide and between rivals nearing the half-mile, chased three wide to the quarter marker, angled five wide to upper stretch and bid at the furlong pole, yielded in the late stages and was outfinished for the minor awards. INNER FURY (IRE) was forwardly placed while four deep early on, tracked the pace three wide into the backstretch, chased the pace to the quarter pole, could not keep pace to upper stretch and gave way in the lane. MAYBE SO fractious in the starting gate, showed early speed and assumed command away from the start, set the pace to the first turn, carved out a moderate pace to the half-mile and dictated terms to the second turn, met oncoming bids to upper stretch then weakened in the drive. BELMIRA was prominent in the early running, stalked the pace to the backstretch, chased two wide and between foes into the far turn, could not match strides to upper

stretch and tired. SANOVIV was three wide and between foes to the first turn, took back and was well placed to the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn, could not find the needed response nearing the top of the lane and came up empty in the final stages.
