DIMATIC was well placed while outside of rivals in the early going, tracked the decent pace three to four wide nearing the half-mile marker, chased WITHOUT A TRACE to the quarter pole then determinedly closed in the lane, wore down the game runner-up in the final sixteenth and pushed past in deep stretch to prevail. WITHOUT A TRACE hustled away from the gate, assumed early command and set the pace to the backstretch, carved out a decent pace to the quarter marker, dug in into upper stretch and fought gamely while holding off rivals into the final furlong, switched to the left lead in deep stretch and was bested for the win in the final yards, while well clear of the rest for second. MR JAWS settled in the early stages while never far back, ran in pursuit of the leaders two wide along the far turn, got outkicked into the final furlong, kept on in the late stages and held safely in the end for third. PRESIDENTIAL prominent in the early stages, stalked the decent pace two wide and between rivals to the backstretch, bid between foes nearing the quarter pole, lost ground into upper stretch, could not find more in the final furlong and weakened. STANS HOME RUN unhurried in the early going, saved ground to the half-mile marker, shifted out into the far turn, angled widest to upper stretch and lacked the needed late response.

NOW HEAR THIS sent for the early lead, assumed command and showed speed to the turn, controlled the pace to the quarter marker then drew off into the lane, was ridden out in the late stages and won as much the best. ITTY BITTY BABY hopped at the break and was last away from the gate, settled in the early going then advanced into the turn, navigated traffic to upper stretch then split foes into the final furlong, could not impact the winner in the final sixteenth but stayed on late and earned the place honors. PAROLA SICURA settled in the early stages, coaxed outside of rivals heading to the turn, swung five to six wide to upper stretch, made a mild rally through the lane and just missed for second, while clear of the rest for third. LUMINA broke a step slowly but was away in good order, tracked the decent early pace from the inside, was well placed while saving ground to the turn, chased from the inside into upper stretch, lacked the needed response in deep stretch and was outfinished for the minor awards. HOT PINK broke alertly and was close up to the early pace while outside of rivals, tracked three wide to the turn, spun four wide into the lane, got outkicked to upper stretch and gave way in the final stages. MAYBE SO was prominent away from the gate while between rivals, chased the pace two wide and between foes into the turn, lacked the needed response when called upon into upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong.

FLASHOUT sent leaving the start, assumed early command and set the pace to the turn, showed the way to the quarter marker and was set down for the drive, dug in into the final furlong then held off foes into the final sixteenth, drifted out while under pressure in deep stretch and lasted for the win. AMERICAN WITT was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the pace three wide into the turn then chased the pacesetter into the lane, responded well in the stretch drive and rallied on the left lead into deep stretch, came up just short for the win and got up in time to earn the place honors. HEAT UM UP raced close up to the early pace, chased two wide and between rivals into the turn, ran in pursuit three wide into the stretch, was held at bay into the final furlong, could not muster the needed late response and was outkicked for second in the final yards, while holding clearly for third. CHIEF BROWN was forwardly placed in the early going while inside of runners, tracked the pace while saving ground into the turn, ran in pursuit two to three wide into the lane, could not keep pace with the leaders into the final furlong and did not rally late. SHANGHAI CHARLIE broke awkwardly and spotted the field to begin, trailed into the turn then advanced outside of rivals nearing the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in the late stages. CINCO WAR PAINT allowed to settle early on, coaxed three then two wide into the turn, ran in pursuit two wide into the lane and did not threaten late. TEXAS HUNK settled off of the early pace while never far back, was a bit hard to place while between runners heading to the turn, chased two wide to the quarter marker then shifted inside into upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and weakened. FOUR JIM tracked the early pace while widest along the backstretch, chased four then three wide into the turn, could not keep pace nearing the quarter pole and came up empty in the stretch drive.

WITT'S LIL RINGER showed good speed away from the start, vied for the early lead from between foes then set the pace to the turn, shook free into the bend and showed the way to the quarter pole, drew off while in hand into upper stretch, was given a reminder tap of the crop into the final sixteenth and held sway to the wire. TIFFANY TAP settled off of the early pace, advanced two then three wide nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit of WITT'S LIL RINGER into the upper stretch, rallied while on the left lead into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner late but was well clear of the rest for second. WHISPERIN LIZ was forwardly placed in the early stages, chased three then wide into the turn, could not keep pace with the winner into the lane, weakened in the final sixteenth but held safely in the end for third. PARTY GAL got shuffled at the start and trailed in the early going, saved ground into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch, kept on into the final furlong but could not muster the needed late response. LOVEREIGNORME settled in the second flight and tracked outside of foes along the backstretch, advanced three to four wide into the turn, was outranked to upper stretch then gave way in the drive. PURLY DIALED IN broke in at the start, was hustled to be forwardly placed in the early stages, saved ground into the turn and dropped back along the bend, coaxed two to three wide into the stretch and passed tiring rivals late. CHARLIE'S A ROCKIN got crowded at the start and broke a step slowly, was hard sent in the early stages and pressed the pace inside of WITT'S LIL RINGER heading to the turn, dropped back along the turn then tired in the stretch drive. CHARGENLUCKY was crowded at the start and off slowly, settled off of the early pace, coaxed four to five wide into the turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and did not factor late. VANCOUVER VALOR settled in the second flight early on, tracked the pace between rivals along the backstretch, ran in pursuit three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response in upper stretch and came up empty in the final stages.
