INNER FURY (IRE) raced close up to the early pace, was a bit keen into the first turn and took command between foes into the backstretch run, set the pace from the two path heading into the far turn, dug in into the stretch, gamely held off foes into the final sixteenth and lasted for the win. KARA broke a step slowly then settled to the first turn, advanced three wide along the backstretch, shifted to the rail into the far turn and rallied along the inside to mid-stretch, surged in the final sixteenth and just missed for the win, while holding for the place. STRIKE THE BELL was forwardly placed in the early running, stalked the modest pace three wide heading to the quarter marker, gamely battled into the stretch, was outfinished in the final sixteenth and was well clear of the rest for third. GOSPEL TIZ GOT broke alertly and vied for the early lead, took back into the first turn, tracked the pace while saving ground along the backstretch run, gave way into the far turn and lacked a further response. RON'S LAVENDER settled while saving ground into the first turn, chased two wide and between foes heading to the far turn, could not find the needed response at the quarter pole and tired in the stretch drive.

CHEATING HEART tracked the early pace from the inside, was well placed to the turn then chased from the inside into upper stretch, tipped out at the furlong pole, made a quick move to take command into the final sixteenth and drew off under hand urging in deep stretch. SIX IRON went up to press the early pace from the inside, dueled from the inside heading into the turn, took command to upper stretch and led inside of the furlong marker, was overtaken at the sixteenth-marker, could not keep pace with the winner late and was second best. BINARY CODE was prominent in the early stages, stalked the leading pair three deep into the turn, was well placed to the quarter pole and ran in pursuit outside of foes into the stretch, could not keep pace with the top pair into the final sixteenth but was clear at the wire for third. POLLITO TITO broke in at the start and crowded inner rivals, was close up to the early pace then took back along the backstretch run, tracked three wide and between rivals into the turn, gave chase into upper stretch, needed more in the late stages but improved position in the final sixteenth. OBVIOUS CONCLUSION settled in the second flight early on, raced widest along the backstretch run then chased four wide into the turn, ran in pursuit to the furlong pole and did not rally late. GRIND JIM broke slowly and was allowed to settle early, coaxed two wide to the quarter pole, angled widest into the stretch and improved position late. DAPILOT was forwardly placed early on then took back, chased two wide into the turn, got to the rail nearing the quarter marker then ran in pursuit into upper stretch, could not find the needed response in the drive and did not threaten late. RACE AROUND broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace between rivals to the quarter marker, was overtaken to upper stretch and gave way in the drive. FANDO threw his head then was crowded at the start and was off slowly, lacked speed to the turn, trailed to the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch and did not factor late.

STORMY AT MIDNIGHT lunged at the start and was off a bit slowly, rushed up along the inside and took command in the early stages, set a solid pace while clear nearing the quarter marker, held a clear lead into upper stretch, kept to task past the furlong marker and held sway to the wire. ROARING RAPIDS settled off of the solid early pace and saved ground up the backstretch, maintained an inside path into the turn, angled four wide to upper stretch, finished well into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and earned a share of the place honors. WON MORE TIME rated just off of the early pace, was well placed while three wide into the turn then ran in pursuit to upper stretch, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and earned a share of the place honors. WAR SPIRIT was forwardly placed early on while outside of rivals, chased the pace three wide into the turn, ran in pursuit of STORMY AT MIDNIGHT into upper stretch, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and just missed for the minor awards. CHARMING OAKIE showed good early speed and vied for the lead along the backstretch run, chased two wide and between foes into the turn, ran in pursuit into upper stretch then could not muster the needed response in the final sixteenth. METRONOME settled off of the early pace while never far back,

shifted to the four path into the turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch and finished evenly in the drive. MONEYSTRIKE stumbled at the start and was late away from the gate, advanced between rivals approaching the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and did not factor in the drive. COMPRESSED broke out at the start and was allowed to settle early, trailed into the turn, shifted out to upper stretch and passed a pair of tiring rivals in the late stages. GYPSY MISCHIEF hustled to contest the early pace, chased STORMY AT MIDNIGHT while saving ground into the turn, ran in pursuit from the inside into upper stretch, could not find more at the furlong pole and gave way. GHURAIR'S WARRIOR was crowded at the start and off slowly, settled along the backstretch then was coaxed three wide into the turn, lacked the needed response into upper stretch and did not make a late impact.

MACHO GRANDE was allowed to settle while never far back early on, saved ground to the far turn then was asked for run nearing the quarter marker, tipped out to upper stretch and between bid rivals at the furlong pole, led into the final sixteenth and held under firm handling in deep stretch. NAUTICAL MOON settled to the first turn, roused three wide at the half-mile marker, made a steady advance to upper stretch and responded in the drive, finished well but could not get by the winner in deep stretch and held safely for the place. BROCK ON BY broke alertly then ceded the early lead, tracked the pace three wide into the backstretch run, was well placed to the half-mile marker, chased into the far turn then spun four wide to upper stretch, bid five wide past the furlong pole, was outkicked in deep stretch and was a clear third. SEND OFF settled to the first turn then lagged along the backstretch run, saved ground to the quarter pole, found his best stride late but could not threaten the leaders in deep stretch. COASTAL BRINK tracked the early pace from between rivals, was well placed to the backstretch and prompted the pace to the far turn, chased MACKINNON to the quarter pole, spun three then four wide to upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong and weakened late. MACKINNON hustled away from the gate, assumed command into the first turn, set a decent pace while well handled to the half-mile marker, showed the way to the quarter marker then dug in into the stretch, was overtaken at the furlong marker and faded in the late stages. SLIM JIMMY settled in the early stages while never far back, tracked the pace two wide and between runners heading to the half-mile, dropped back along the far turn then came up empty in the stretch drive.

PROVEN ADVOCATE settled while saving ground in the early stages, maintained a rail path to the second turn, gained ground two wide at the quarter marker, shifted back to the rail in upper stretch and loomed at the furlong pole, took command past mid-stretch, kicked clear into the final sixteenth and was ridden out in the late stages to win as much the best. COLONEL YORKE settled mid-pack and three wide early on, was reserved through the backstretch run then chased the pacesetter three wide into the far turn, rallied and vied for the lead nearing the furlong grounds, was no match for the winner into the final sixteenth but kept on late to be second best. CINCO RICHIE settled mid-pack and between rivals, was reserved through the backstretch run and caught in a bit of traffic at the three-eighths then angled four wide nearing the quarter pole, rallied to mid-stretch, needed more in the late stages but ran on in deep stretch to earn the show honors. BOBBY BRINKLEY was prominent away from the start, ceded the early lead and tracked the loose leader while saving ground into the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the far turn, chased MOR VICTORY to the quarter pole then ran in pursuit two wide into the stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth and just missed for third on the wire. MOR VICTORY sent for the early lead, drew off into the backstretch run and carved out solid fractions while clear into the far turn, came under pressure into upper stretch, was overtaken at the furlong marker then faded in the final sixteenth. RAROTONGA was unhurried to the backstretch, trailed to the quarter marker then swung widest to upper stretch, gained ground nearing the furlong pole, could not sustain that run to the final sixteenth and flattened out. REGAL TERKA settled three wide to the first turn, was unhurried along the

backstretch then roused four wide into the second turn, swung five wide to upper stretch, chased on the left lead to the furlong pole, needed more in the late stages and did not threaten the leaders in deep stretch. JUST BERNIE settled in mid-pack and saved ground to the first turn, saved all of the ground along the backstretch run and into the far turn, got caught in traffic in upper stretch, was outkicked to the furlong pole and could not muster the needed late response. VIETNAM VICTORY was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the loose leader two wide along the backstretch run, chased three wide into the far turn, could not find more into upper stretch and gave way in the drive.
