BLUE HEAVENLY broke well, vied between horses into the first turn for the early lead, settled just behind GEE I'M FOXY, pulled even near the quarter pole, dueled to mid-stretch, then drew clear in the final furlong under a strong hand ride. OUR DAVINA was the trailer to the far turn, then rallied late to gain the place. GEE I'M FOXY won the race to the first turn, then was left to dictate the early fractions, held sway to the far turn, dug in under a threat from BLUE HEAVENLY at the quarter pole, then gave way in the final furlong. MOONLIGHT GAMBLER settled near the back through the early stages while saving ground, moved up through the turn, but could not sustain the effort and flattened. STORY HOUR veered out at the start, causing some chaos to the outside starters, was close up three wide early, but flattened out in the stretch. SHE'SSKYSTHELIMIT got pinched back after the start, went three-wide through the first turn, and continued the same path down the backstretch and through the far turn, swung out five-wide for the stretch run but lacked a rally. SAN MATEO KAT got sandwiched between horses after the start, moved up and was forwardly placed to the far turn, and tired. COMPENDIUM dropped far behind on the backstretch, was eased across the wire far behind the rest, and transported from the track via the equine ambulance.

BRINK OF WAR broke well, but ceded the lead while staying in the four-wide stalking position, moved up to bid three-wide into the stretch, battled a gain TIZ ANOTHER BUNNY to the wire, and got a favorable head bob at the line. TIZ ANOTHER BUNNY pressed the pace three-wide, bid for the lead leaving the quarter pole, dueled with BRINK OF WAR to the finish, was headed late, then game back and just missed in a photo finish. READY AND ABLE was bothered after the start by CARRIBEAN DREAM, then raced in mid-pack early, then rallied through the stretch to gain third, but was no threat to the top two. LEBOMBO settled at the back early, saved ground to the lane and improved despite racing on the wrong lead through the stretch. CARIBBEAN DREAM moved up after the start to take the lead along the rail, responded when challenged by TIZ ANOTHER BUNNY approaching the quarter pole, but weakened in mid-stretch. TRANSOM BAY ducked in at the start and was off slowly and was a distant last early, made a nice middle move four-wide through the turn, but flattened in upper stretch. CLOCKIN IN pressed the early pace two-deep, gave way leaving the three-furlong pole, and had nothing left for the stretch run. MUCAFAAH raced at the back and never threatened.

KISS MY DICE chased the pacesetter and eventual winner to the stretch, kept on well to outfinish the rest and take down the second prize. DOUBLEBARRELVINNY broke a step slow, raced near the back to the stretch, then found another gear late and finished up well to gain third. BELLA BLU MOON was hustled to get into the early mix, settled in behind the pace, dropped back, then improved in the stretch while never a serious threat. AUNT PENNY raced in mid-pack, then was outfinished in the stretch. HARVEY'S FINNISH was the trailer to the stretch, then lacked a meaningful rally and was unable to improve. TEXAS SPEED QUEEN veered out sharply after the start, pressed the pace three-deep, the weakened in the stretch.

WITT'S TEN TOUCH got bumped and carried inward by HIGH CINCO at the start, raced in mid-pack in the three-path, weakened under a drive from the quarter pole, and tired in the stretch.
