TEXAS HOLDEM reserved in the early stages, saved ground to the turn, was roused nearing the quarter marker then made a quick rail move into upper stretch, battled inside of HERO TIME to mid-stretch, turned away the runner-up in the final sixteenth and kicked clear late. HERO TIME well placed in the early stages, tracked the pace between foes then saved ground into the turn, made a two wide bid into upper stretch, met the bid of TEXAS HOLDEM into the lane and battled that rival to mid-stretch, traveled on the left lead into the final sixteenth, could not keep pace with the winner in deep stretch and held for second. UNION DATA tracked the early pace from between runners, chased two to three wide into the turn, made an inside bid into the stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth but stayed on well late and just missed for the place. SUITABLE had a shoe repaired prior to the race, led in the early stages then ceded to DOSE'S DREAM and stalked that rival to the turn, attended to the decent pace nearing the quarter marker, battled and ran in pursuit into upper stretch, could not find the needed response late and faded. SAM SEZ showed early speed and vied for the lead away from the start, tracked the pace two to three wide nearing the quarter marker, chased into the stretch and remained within contention nearing the furlong grounds, could not keep pace into the final sixteenth and weakened. FIFTEEN LOVE BACK took back off of the decent early pace, swung widest into upper stretch and gained at the furlong marker, was not able to threaten into the late stages and passed tiring rivals in the final sixteenth. SR. BI BI settled outside of rivals to begin, chased four to five wide nearing the quarter marker, had the rider lose his crop into upper stretch and could not muster a late response. DOSE'S DREAM hustled in the early stages, assumed command and set the pace into the turn, was overtaken into upper stretch and tired in the drive. MY LITTLE PRINCE close up early, tracked three to four wide to the quarter marker, ran evenly to mid-stretch and gave way.

EXCAPING THE BLUES prominent early, stalked the pace between rivals along the first turn, attended to the decent pace through the backstretch, roused at the quarter marker, confronted TRANSACTIONAL and battled that rival to mid-stretch, found more into the final sixteenth and drew away late under hand urging. TRANSACTIONAL (GB) sent to assume early command, set decent fractions while prompted up the backstretch, confronted by EXCAPING THE BLUES into the stretch, battled that rival to the furlong grounds, was no match for the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. MR INSENSITIVE settled in the second flight to begin, chased three to four wide into the stretch, could not keep pace with the top pair into the final sixteenth and got up in for the show honors. SUMMER LOVER close up early on, tracked three wide to the first turn, tucked inside and was well placed while tracking along the backstretch, saved ground to the quarter marker, weakened in the stretch drive and just missed for the show. KERAUNOS well placed while tracking the early pace from the inside, saved ground to the top of the lane, could not muster a late response and was outfinished for the show honors. DEN'S GOOD GRACE settled two wide and between runners into the first turn, shifted inside and saved ground to the second turn, chased two wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. MIAMI MOONLIGHT settled and saved ground into the first turn, chased two to three wide into upper stretch and failed to threaten in the late stages. MISTER MONTE CARLO settled three wide into the first turn, unhurried while two wide and between runners through the backstretch, saved ground into the far turn and did not offer the needed late response. SINGING DIXIE settled three to four wide into the first turn, unhurried while widest through the backstretch, chased three wide to the quarter marker and did not factor late. BAY BE GONE settled while saving ground early, swung widest into the stretch and could not make a late impact.

ANGEL KISS off a step slow to begin, was hustled between runners early on and pressed the pace to the turn, prompted MOR PEANUTS to the quarter marker then battled that rival into the stretch, battled gamely into the final sixteenth, wore down MOR PEANUTS into deep stretch and inched clear late to prove best. GHOSTLY NIGHT tracked the early pace while widest up the backstretch, well placed nearing the quarter marker while five wide, closed willingly in the stretch drive, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and got up in time to secure the place honors. MOR PEANUTS showed good speed away from the start and assumed early command, set the pace from the inside into the turn, met the bid of ANGEL KISS into upper stretch and battled that rival to the final sixteenth, was outfinished by the top pair in deep stretch and held safely for the show. CHAPARRITA tracked the early pace three wide and between runners, ran in pursuit into the turn and was well placed nearing the quarter marker, lost ground into upper stretch and finished evenly. INARI rated off of the early pace, chased two to three wide to the stretch and could not muster a late response. PLEASINGLY chased the early pace four wide and between runners, well placed nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked into the stretch then got caught in tight between rivals at mid-stretch and weakened late. AUTISM RESILIENCE hard to load prior to the start, raced close up to the early pace then took back approaching the turn, saved ground to the stretch and came up empty in the drive.

CAVALLINO RAMPANTE took back off of the early pace, tracked two to three wide nearing the quarter marker, chased four wide into upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. PICCOLO UOMO tracked the pace two wide and between runners, ran in pursuit to the quarter marker, could not keep pace into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. NIGHTLINGER broke in at the start and was off slowly, saved ground into the turn and did not make a late impact. TOUGH TROOPER allowed to settle, swung six wide into the stretch and was not a late threat. SHAMAYIM unhurried away from the start and saved ground into the first turn, saved all of the ground along the backstretch and into the second turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, closed determinedly into the final sixteenth, wore down foes in deep stretch and inched clear in the final strides.
