BURNING SHORES AA assumed early command and set the pace to the turn, shook free along the bend and set the pace to the quarter pole while off of the rail, met the bid of TRIUMPH AA into upper stretch, determinedly battled that game foe to the final sixteenth, dug in in deep stretch and held in the final strides to prevail. TRIUMPH AA lunged at the start, broke awkwardly and was slow away from the gate, recovered and tracked the early pace between runners heading to the turn, got caught in traffic midway through the bend and steadied at the five-sixteenths, found room along the rail at the quarter marker and bid for the lead into the stretch, dueled BURNING SHORES AA to the final sixteenth, was gamely bested in deep stretch and was a clear second. UPTOWN HASTAMANANA chased the early pace while widest up the backstretch, ran in pursuit five wide nearing the quarter marker, could not make headway on the top pair in the stretch drive and was well clear of the rest for third. AA HOT ASSETS forwardly placed early, stalked the pace while saving ground to the turn, angled three wide nearing the quarter pole, was outrun to the furlong marker and gave way. WMA MADJIC SLIPPERS raced close up to the early pace, tracked three wide to the quarter pole, ran in pursuit four wide into the stretch, could not find the needed response in the stretch and tired in the drive. WMA NASH RAMBLER tracked the early pace four wide and between runners, well placed to the turn, could not keep pace nearing the quarter pole and came up empty in the stretch drive. WMA FAST KASH lacked early speed and trailed throughout.

MANOR BORN vied for the early lead out of the chute, assumed command and set the pace from the inside into the first turn, set modest fractions while well rated through the backstretch, set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, met the bid of RODEO CHAMP into upper stretch, dug in while holding a narrow lead into the final sixteenth, was unyielding in deep stretch and lasted in the final strides for a determined win. RODEO CHAMP prominent early while a bit keen and inside of runners, checked and shifted outside of MANOR BORN and prompted that runner through modest fractions into the backstretch, attended to the pace to the second turn, raced on even terms with MANOR BORN into the stretch and dueled that rival to the final sixteenth, fought gamely to deep stretch and just missed for the win, while holding safely for the place. BROTHER REID allowed to settle while never far back, saved ground to the second turn then waited for racing room nearing the quarter marker, tipped three wide into the stretch and bid at the furlong marker, could not reel in the top pair into the final sixteenth and held well in the end for the show. HEIR TO GREATNESS well placed while saving ground to the first turn, tracked the modest fractions from the inside along the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the quarter pole then tipped three to four wide into the lane, could not find a final response and just missed for the show. BRUCELEA settled just off of the early pace, tracked between foes up the backstretch run, was shuffled back a bit nearing the half-mile pole, roused four to five wide at the quarter pole, bid into the stretch, needed more in the late stages and was outkicked in deep stretch. BIG COMMERCE stalked the early pace three wide and between runners, well placed into the backstretch, chased three wide and between runners nearing the quarter pole, lost position into upper stretch and gave way in the drive. ICEATUDE tracked the early pace four wide into the first turn, widest up the backstretch while well placed, chased three wide to the quarter pole and tired in the stretch drive.

TEXAS RED BEL showed good early speed and assumed command, set a pressured pace to the turn, carved out decent fractions while prompted to the quarter pole, shook free into the stretch, kept to task past the furlong marker and was ridden out in the late stages to win as much the best. SERAPE sent to dispute the early pace, engaged with TEXAS RED BEL and pressed outside of that rival to the turn, kept close attendance to the decent pace nearing the quarter pole, could not keep pace with the winner into the stretch, chased into the final sixteenth and held well late for second. EAGLE EXPRESS tracked the early pace four wide nearing the half-mile marker, shifted to the two path into the turn and chased the pace to the quarter pole, angled out into upper stretch, could not find the needed late response and got up in time to secure the show honors. WA WA WEE WA tracked the early pace three wide nearing the half-mile marker, shifted to the rail into the turn and chased the pace to the quarter pole, made a mild gain into the stretch, flattened out in the final sixteenth and was outfinished for third. TAY TAY'S BABY settled off of the decent early pace, chased two wide and between runners nearing the quarter pole, swung four to five wide into the stretch, could not threaten the leaders into the final furlong and passed tiring rivals late. CLAUDETTE HEIR a step slow away from the start, settled while saving ground in the early stages, shifted three wide into upper stretch and did not offer a late response. GEORGIANO chased the early pace three wide and between runners, lost ground into the turn, shifted to the rail into upper stretch and failed to threaten.

SECRET KNOCK showed good early speed away from the start, engaged with GLITTERS ANDIE and dueled inside of that runner to the turn, disputed decent fractions to the quarter pole, shook free into the stretch and drew clear at the furlong marker, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held sway under hand urging in deep stretch. FUNDING SOURCE prominent early, stalked the contested pace three wide to the turn, shifted inside and chased two wide and between runners nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit while on the left lead into the stretch, mildly re-rallied in the late stages and got up for the place honors. MISSY GURL close up in the early going, chased three to four wide to the turn, loomed at the quarter pole, swung wide into the lane, needed more into the stretch drive and just missed for the place at the wire. CIRCA STAR chased the early pace from between runners, saved ground into the turn and was well placed at the quarter marker, ran in pursuit into the stretch, could not find more into the final sixteenth and was outkicked in deep stretch. MAYBELLY tracked the early pace from outside of runners, chased four wide into the turn and advanced at the quarter marker, ran in pursuit into the stretch and lacked a final response. COASTAL BRINK broke alertly, ceded the early lead and tracked the decent pace while saving ground, well placed through the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the quarter pole, angled out into upper stretch, closed willingly in the late stages, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and was second best. MOON CAT settled two wide into the first turn, unhurried through the backstretch run, saved ground into the second turn and improved position at the quarter pole, angled four wide into the stretch, could not impact the top pair late but was able to close the gap in deep stretch and was a clear third. GOLD PRIZE settled along the inside into the first turn, tracked the moderate pace between runners up the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn and advanced into the stretch, could not sustain that run in the drive and flattened out in the final sixteenth.
