OKLAHOMA FLAME was sent from the break and went a length clear early, shook off a challenge from MAJOR ORTIZ near the quarter pole, opened up, and held clear under steady handling and urging as that rival came back on in the final yards. MAJOR ORTIZ stalked OKLAHOMA FLAME through the early stages, then moved up to challenge approaching the quarter pole, was turned back at that point, but kept trying, came back in the stretch to lose the margin late, but ran out of time. ONE DEAL raced two-wide with the tracking group, moved up to chase the top two to the stretch, came under pressure leaving the quarter pole, and chased those rivals to the wire a mile clear of the next finisher. GUS CAUSE broke a step slow, then was far back in the early going, started to run on from the three-furlong pole and improved. RANGER TOWN raced inside with the tracking group down the backstretch, then dropped out of contention on the turn and had little to offer in the stretch. HANK RIDGE trailed, saved ground to the stretch, then passed a couple of tired rivals in the late stages. PREACHERMAN broke well tracked widest of all down the backstretch, then launched a bid three-wide through the turn, but flattened out and weakened in upper stretch. TEXAS TOUGH chased in the four-path mid-pack, then lacked a finish.
