IMUA KAI ceded the early lead and stalked between runners into the first turn, attended to the moderate pace while well positioned nearing the half-mile, tracked MO SATURDAYS to the quarter pole then roused into the stretch, took command inside of the furlong marker and drew away under firm late handling. MO SATURDAYS showed speed away from the start and assumed early command, cleared into the first turn and set moderate fractions into the backstretch, dictated terms to the second turn and maintained a clear lead to the quarter pole, came under pressure into the stretch, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. TWENTY ONE SKIDOO settled four then three wide into the first turn, settled while never far back through the backstretch then chased into the second turn, ran in pursuit four wide into the stretch, could not impact the top pair into the final sixteenth and ran on to be a clear third. WITT'S TAQUITO settled while saving ground into the backstretch run, saved all of the ground to the second turn, waited for racing room nearing the quarter marker, chased from the rail into the stretch, made a mild gain at the furlong marker and passed tiring rivals in the late stages. REGAL TERKA settled two wide and between runners into the first turn, was caught in tight into the bend and was shuffled a bit nearing the six furlong pole, tracked outside of runners up the backstretch, chased three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, was caught five to six wide into the lane, ran evenly to mid-stretch and flattened in the late stages. WILTON unhurried early, advanced two wide and between runners into the second turn, ran evenly to mid-stretch, failed to threaten in the final sixteenth and passed tiring rivals late. GLENDALE settled in the second flight to begin, raced three wide along the first turn then tucked in into the backstretch run, saved ground to the far turn, swung widest into upper stretch and did not factor late. CRAZY RIDGE well placed away from the start, saved ground to the first turn and tracked the moderate pace into the backstretch, saved all of the ground to the second turn, asked for run into the stretch, lacked a response in the final furlong and gave way. BRILLIANT SPIN settled and saved ground to the first turn, advanced between runners into the backstretch, was caught in tight into the second turn and was boxed in nearing the quarter pole, found room into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. SAGITTARIUS forwardly placed early, tracked the pace three wide to the first turn, stalked the moderate pace

three deep to the half-mile pole, lost ground three wide into the second turn, was outrun into upper stretch and faltered in the final furlong.

UP UP AND AWAY settled off of the early pace, made a steady advance while widest up the backstretch, loomed three wide nearing the quarter marker, took command into upper stretch then drew clear at the furlong marker, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held sway under hand urging in the late stages. HARD GOLD close up to the early pace, took back and tracked outside of runners into the backstretch, well placed nearing the far turn, saved ground while advancing nearing the quarter pole, angled three wide into upper stretch, chased UP UP AND AWAY through the lane, could not make headway on the winner into the final sixteenth and was a clear second best. HELLO HELLO MISTER hustled away from the start, vied for the early lead then ceded to SHARP LORENZO and tracked that runner into the backstretch, attended to the moderate pace nearing the half-mile, chased two wide and between runners heading to the quarter pole, floated four wide into upper stretch, could not keep pace with the top pair into the final sixteenth and was clear for the show. SHARP LORENZO vied for the early lead, assumed command along the first turn and set a moderate pace into the backstretch, controlled the pace to the half-mile pole, dictated terms into the second turn then came under pressure at the quarter pole, was overtaken into upper stretch and tired in the drive. CAPOTE'S GLITTER hopped then was squeezed at the start and was away slowly, settled along the inside into the first turn, trailed into the backstretch and was never a factor.

DEVIL'S MISCHIEF rated nicely while just off of the early pace, shifted three to four wide and tracked the pace to the turn, loomed along the bend and took a narrow lead at the quarter pole, battled STORM MAN into upper stretch, shook free at the furlong grounds then drew away in the final stages. STORM MAN sent away from the start, vied for the early lead then assumed command and set the pace to the turn, set a decent pace into the bend then was overtaken at the quarter marker, battled DEVIL'S MISCHIEF into upper stretch, could not keep pace with the winner into the final sixteenth and held well late for the place. SLEW SKIES settled off of the early pace, raced widest to the turn, advanced four wide nearing the quarter marker then ran evenly to mid-stretch, could not match strides with the top pair late and stayed on to hold safely for the show. PRIORITY LANE tracked the decent early pace while well placed and inside of runners, tipped two wide for the drive and battled to mid-stretch, could not muster a response into the final sixteenth and weakened late. TI CAILLOU chased the early pace, shifted outside of runners and ran in pursuit three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, chased into upper stretch and did not offer a late response. GREAT EXCAPER vied for the early lead away from the start, ceded to STORM MAN and tracked outside of that rival approaching the turn, chased two to three wide and between runners into the bend, could not keep pace into the stretch and tired. KRISYNSARASBOY paused at the start then broke a bit awkwardly and was slow away from the gate, lacked early speed and was not a factor.

PINKY RING BLING vied for the early lead while widest up the backstretch, pressed the pace five wide to the turn, chased three wide to the quarter pole, battled four wide into the stretch, vied for the lead at the furlong marker then battled UNITED PATRIOT into the final sixteenth, shook free in deep stretch and lasted for the win at the wire. MACHO GRANDE settled off off the contentious early pace, advanced two to three wide and between runners along the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, responded to urging in the drive and loomed at mid-stretch, closed fast in the final sixteenth and just missed for the win, while getting up in time for the place. UNITED PATRIOT rated just off of the early pace, tracked from the inside to the turn, raced in tight along the bend then found room along the rail into upper stretch, vied for the lead nearing the furlong pole, battled stubbornly to the final sixteenth and was outfinished in deep stretch. COUSIN LARRY a bit slow to begin leaving the start, trailed in the early stages and saved ground to the turn, saved all of the ground to upper stretch, navigated traffic along the rail into the final furlong and was outkicked in deep stretch. BARBACOA settled off of the contested early pace while never far back, chased three wide to the turn, slipped to the inside at the quarter pole then angled out into upper stretch, bid at the furlong marker, could not

find the needed late response and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. FAST TRAFFIC slow away from the start, settled outside of rivals in the early going, advanced four wide at the quarter pole, swung six wide into the lane and continued his run to mid-stretch, could not sustain his bid into the final sixteenth and flattened out late. ABSOLUTE COURAGE prominent early, vied for the lead from between runners heading to the half-mile marker, chased four wide and between foes to the turn, lost position nearing the quarter pole then faltered in the stretch drive. GET WITT GONE raced close up to the early pace while between runners, chased three wide and between foes to the turn, lost ground at the quarter marker and gave way in the stretch.

LIUZZA prominent early, ceded the lead and stalked two wide into the first turn, tracked three wide and between rivals into the backstretch, was roused three wide into the far turn and vied for the lead at the quarter pole, battled then took command into upper stretch, was set down for the drive and kicked clear into the final furlong, kept to task to the final sixteenth and held over the oncoming runner-up. GEOMETRIQUE unhurried early, saved ground to the second turn, shifted out and chased four wide to the quarter pole, swung widest for the stretch drive, was full of run into the final sixteenth and just missed for the win, while besting the rest. QUEEN OF SALSAS forwardly placed early, tracked the pace three wide to the first turn, well placed along the backstretch, chased three to four wide into the far turn, churned on into the stretch, could not match strides with the top pair into the final sixteenth and closed late for third. DRENCHED vied for the early lead inside of runners, ceded the lead along the first turn then stalked the pacesetter into the backstretch, re-bid between foes into the backstretch and took a narrow lead at the half-mile, battled between runners into the far turn, was overtaken by LIUZZA into upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and weakened in deep stretch.
