TELEKINETIC was allowed to settle from the break, then was content to track mid-pack to the far turn, started to run on with three furlongs to go, loomed four wide at the top of the stretch, had trouble changing leads and lugged in under a heavy drive, but finished best to win clear in the end. TAPS MISTRESS ranged three wide through the first turn, stalked the pace three wide to the far turn, went to challenge for the lead after passing the three furlong marker, engaged in a three-way battle down the stretch, took short lead with a furlong to run but could not hold off the winner. SCHOOL TEACHER was far back through the early stages, then rallied late to be along for third while no threat to the top two. SHAKE THOSE DICE was a bit keen early, then settled down and rated mid-pack down the backstretch, responded when cued to go on the far turn, loomed at the top of the stretch then was unable to sustain the bid and finished evenly. GOLLY HOLLY settled into a tracking position along the rail and was content to sit behind the early pace for the first half mile, was asked to go on leaving three furlong pole, loomed a big threat approaching the top of the stretch then flattened out. ZED seized the early lead, rated kindly under confident handling, was set down at the head of the stretch and won clear under steady handling and intermittent urging while drifting out a bit in the late stages. SOUND OF VICTORY unhurried early and settled and the back of the tracking group, advanced steadily up the rail down the backstretch to be in striking distance by the far turn, came under urging from the quarter pole, was looking to get clear in upper stretch but had the path blocked, tipped out in the clear at the eighth pole and finished willingly to gain the place. READY AND ABLE was pushed on early to get forward position but got caught four wide into the first turn, stayed in the clear down the backstretch, slowly advanced closer approaching the far turn, had to be ridden to keep up while losing some position near the three furlong marker, then re-bid, circled the field under a drive came five wide into the stretch and produced a grinding finish to get third. BRODY'S TREASURE broke well but backed out of the developing speed duel then dropped back to nearly last before the turn, stayed in the clear then was steered out five wide into the stretch, had a little trouble with the lead change at the top of the lane the straightened out and produced a steady rally under intermittent urging and was along in time. FLY RED BIRD FLY was hustled from the break, veered out into BETTER EDGE about fifty yards out, tracked the early leader two wide down the backstretch, was pushed to go after the lead after passing the quarter pole, took a slight lead into the stretch was put to strong encouragement while battling with GOLDEN PURSUIT, gamely held that rival at bay but was passed in sight of the wire by the winner. GOLDEN PURSUIT raced up close three wide through the early stages, launched a four wide bid for the lead with three furlongs to run then engaged in a spirited stretch battle with FLY RED BIRD FLY through the stretch, had every chance but could not get by. CONNOR TALKSTRASH broke well, settled mid-pack, saved ground through the turn, tipped out three wide and launched a bid from the five-sixteenths, finished willingly but was not quite good enough. SIR LANCELOT RIDGE broke in a tangle,trailed the field down the backstretch then tried to advance five to six wide on the turn, was kept to task in the stretch

and was able to improve. BETTER EDGE veered out after the start and made contact with TIZ RIGHT ON TIME then was bumped by FLY RED BIRD FLY a few strides later, raced in cover to the turn, then got free past the three-furlong marker, was making a move up the rail into the stretch then had to take up sharply at the three-sixteenths pole, tried to recover but was unable to regain momentum late. BAYOU BOY chased from well back two wide and lacked a late bid. UBSINGINTHEBLUES tracked behind the pace three wide and was never a threat. EAGLE IN THE AIR hustled from the outside post, made the lead and got to the rail by the turn, led the way past the quarter pole then was overtaken in upper stretch. WITT'S RINGER vied inside down the backstretch, ran out of steam before the quarter pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch. TIZ RIGHT ON TIME took a light bump from BETTER EDGE after the break then was put in tight before a furlong and forced to steady, dropped out at that point and was not a factor late. CONSESSION tracked four to five wide to the turn, stopped and was not persevered with once hopelessly behind. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN INVOLVING #5 BETTER EDGE. BATTLE STRIKE was not asked for speed from the break, went two to three wide through the initial bend then settled of the pace as the field turned onto the backstretch, steadily advanced through the middle of the race to reach contention by the far turn, launched a three wide bid from the three furlong maker, came four wide into the stretch and produced a steady finish under strong handling to be along in time. I DON'T GET IT got caught four wide into the first turn but was able to track close three wide turning on to the backstretch, made a three wide bid for the lead passing the quarter, and was outside of the three way battle down the stretch, finished well under steady handling but was outfinished by the winner. SARA'S SHAMAN was hustled from the break, then ceded the lead to SHOTSHELL, took up a stalking position and was content to the far turn, went to challenge for the lead passing the quarter pole, battled that stubborn foe into the stretch with I DON'T GET IT also bidding to the outside, edged clear in deep stretch then was outkicked in the final yards. PROVEN HOPE hustled but was unable to contest early, saved the rail and took up a tracking position, tried to rally into the stretch, had some trouble with the lead change, lost a little momentum then finished up with some interest but was too late. SHARP SPARK lagged well behind through the early going, started to move forward after passing the half-mile marker, made a sustained run on the inside and was closing the margin in the late stages. SHOTSHELL got away from the gate quickly, and established the front end through the clubhouse turn, was left alone to dictate the pace and slowed it down through the first half mile, quickened with three furlongs to run and was challenged by SARA'S SHAMAN and I DON'T GET IT at the quarter pole, fought back gamely to deep stretch then gave way. TWENTYONE N CHANGE came away well then contested the early pace from between horses, steadied into the turn and dropped out of the duel, came back on through the turn, bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, raced briefly on the left lead then finished well under strong handling and prevailed. JACKMAN'S RIDE was sent hard form the outside and was three to four wide in the early pace scramble, dueled through the turn with STAYED ON FOR HALF, battled gamely to the wire under strong handling but came up short. PRAYFORPEACE settled well off the pace while keeping to the inside, started to advance on the turn and carried the rally into the stretch, tipped out three wide into the clear very late and surged but was a little too late. STAYED IN FOR HALF broke well and vied inside in the early pace battle, held position through the turn with a rival still pressing the issue to the outside, battled gamely to the line but was outfinished. TODDCHERO chased inside mid-pack, kept on well late but was not quite good enough to threaten. RANCH BADGE settled off the pace then traveled around the turn in the three path, finished evenly but could not threaten. AVAILABLE STAR saved ground while unable to keep up

with the early pace, was last going into the turn then rallied in the stretch and picked off a few rivals to improve. SIR STERLING was outrun from the break and was under a ride to keep up early and lacked a rally.
