TREVAGGIO got forward inside position for the first half, was coaxed along after passing the half-mile pole to get closer, bided time to the stretch, then tipped out to the three path, responded to strong handling and urging, hit the front by mid-stretch and held off a fast-closing inside rival. MAGNOLIA WEST broke sluggishly, then was unhurried and content to trail early, launched a bit late on the far turn, bid five-wide into the stretch, rallied past the bulk of the field in upper stretch, altered course to the inside near the eighth pole, continued the rally, and just missed. MOHAYMEN HOLIDAY took a small hop at the break but still managed to get to the rail and the lead turning onto the main course, was left alone to dictate pace to the far turn, held sway to the stretch, responded when asked at the top of the stretch, but was outfinished in the final yards. AUSTIN CRUISE tracked two-wide in the middle of the field, finished evenly with a mild gain. COVERT KAT settled near the back two-deep, ran on some in the stretch but was not good enough. CURLINS INCHARGE settled at the back, made a mild rally but could only pass one in the lane. RAROTONGA stalked the pace to the stretch, then weakened and was outrun in the late stages.
