UPTOWN WALK THE LINE broke well and secured the rail position, narrowly led the way with several rivals fanned out across the track in close pursuit, was always traveling well, came into the stretch still in hand, then asserted dominance in the final furlong and was pulling away at the finish. LIKE MOULIN ROUGE was devoid of early speed and far back early, began to decrease the margin on the turn went five wide into the stretch and rallied boldly to get u for the place. TM PURNCESS contest the pace five wide down the backstretch then four wide through the turn, made a run at the eventual winner at the quarter pole but was turned away, chased that one down the stretch and was unable to save the place. AA SWEET VICTORY hopped at the start and spotted the rest a head start, was patiently ridden while saving ground, made some progress to reach contention by the turn and finished evenly in the stretch. WMA BIG BABY raced close up but five to six wide early then struggled to keep up on the turn and finished out one-paced down the lane. QUICK RAE AA raced between horses in the early pace scramble, gave way passing the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. WMA GRAND FINALE vied between horses to the turn, then dropped off the pace approaching the five-sixteenths pole and was not a factor from that point.

HOLD YOUR APPLAUSE was pulling on the rider from the start but rated nicely while being kept two to three wide in the clear, was always close up then went to challenge for the lead at the quarter pole, opened up when set down at the top of the stretch and powered away from the rest while drifting out some in the end. CLIFF DIVER stalked the pacesetter from the rail while under hold, bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole but proved no match for HOLD YOUR APPLAUSE when that one got away, kept on well under strong handling and urging and saved the place while clear of the next horse. PALUXY tracked well behind the pace through the first half mile, had COURAGEOUSLY to the outside, launched a bid with three furlongs to run but became stuck behind horses from the five-sixteenths to the top of the stretch, got clear in upper stretch and responded to strong handling and was gaining late but ran out of time. COURAGEOUSLY tracked two off the rail near the rear of the field with PALUXY to the inside to the half, started a run from the three furlong marker, got a clean run into the stretch, but flattened out a bit in the stretch. RUSSIAN TANK left alone to dictate the pace, set slow fractions to the far turn, tried to fight back when challenged by the eventual winner at the quarter pole but proved no match and weakened in the stretch. THICK HAZE saved ground throughout while tracking a few lengths behind the pace, did not respond when asked on the far turn and was outrun in the late stages. LEVY lacked any speed from the start, went unhurried at the rear of the field and lacked a rally. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

I'M A COWBOY was allowed to settle early, then ranged up five wide on the turn, took over the lead turning into the stretch then finished uncontested to the wire under a drive. BANDERA BLING vied three wide early, came under a drive from the quarter pole and proved no match for the winner but finished willingly to gain second clear of the third horse. WINGS FOR ENO lagged far back early, saved ground through the turn then found best stride late and rallied into the third spot. MY FAVORITE SONG was inside of the five-way pace battle, dug in gamely in the stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth and was outfinished. RAGS ROYAL PRINZ showed good early speed and was sent to the front from the break, was two deep in the early pace scramble through the initial furlongs, battled on to upper stretch then tired. VALDINA DREAMS contested the early pace four wide through the early stages, came five wide into the stretch and was unable to make an impact.

SILVER STEF HIT broke alertly and had forward position going into the first turn, ceded the lead to FIST BUMP RIDGE while settling into a stalking position to the inside, assumed command passing the three furlong marker, came into the stretch with a clear lead then widened under steady handling and intermittent urging. HE'S CHARMING got pinballed at the start but came away forwardly placed in the early stages, tracked two wide in the second flank down the backstretch, bided time in traffic through the far turn, tipped out three wide in the stretch and chased the winner to the wire while well clear of the next horse. IHAVETOOMUCHAIR came away from the gate in good order then settled two then three wide through the first turn near the rear of the field, continued that path through the far turn then finished strong under right handed urging to gain the third spot. MR JAWS broke in and forced HE'S CHARMING into XANDER S at the start, then pushed to get forward position into the first turn, got a good stalking position three wide down the backstretch, then started a bid with three furlongs to run, stalled while lugging in and was unable to threaten. XANDER S broke outward and steadied after making contact with HE'S CHARMING after the break, settled mid-pack on the inside down the backstretch, moved up through the turn and loomed menacingly approaching the quarter pole but failed to produce a rally and was not factor in the stretch. REDFORTYSEVEN lunged, then came away awkwardly at the start, took an inside path through the first turn racing near the rear of the field, became boxed in through the turn on the rail, waited for room to the top of the stretch then did not go on when asked and finished evenly. C J'S MISCHIEF raced in the middle of the second flight under cover to the far turn then lacked a rally once clear in the stretch. LEONARDO CREED was unhurried from the break then settled inside at the rear of the field through the early stages,

moved into contention approaching the three furlong pole but found the path blocked, stayed to the inside through the turn, still behind horses, then had little to offer in the stretch. FIST BUMP RIDGE took the lead into the first turn and set a pressured pace to the far turn, gave way before the three furlong marker and steadily faded through the field on the turn and had nothing to offer late. FAIR WEATHER FLYER was caught four wide through the initial bend then continued to track on the outside of the field, came under a ride on the far turn but came up empty in the stretch.
