SIX IRON broke sharply and was guided to the front to take a narrow early lead, and extended the lead midway through the turn, was given a quick shake of the reins after passing the three-sixteenths pole, and drew away under a very mild hand ride. TAKE MY MONEY got squeezed at the start, then raced at the rear of the compact field, never far from the front in the early stages, advanced three then four wide on the turn and finished up well to move into the second spot. HOLIDAY RUN was close in down the backstretch while being coaxed along to keep pace, came out to the three path for the stretch run and improved to gain the minor award. TIZ CONSIDERED tracked close up three-wide, then went evenly through the stretch and did not threaten. UPTOWNEAGLESLANDED tracked two-deep just behind the pacesetter, got an inside run through the turn, loomed, then flattened out in the stretch. IMMA BLINGY LAD lost the path and got shuffled back at the start, chased four-wide, moved up while still wide on the turn, then had nothing to offer in the stretch.

MARC was guided to the front from the break, made the lead into the first turn, set reasonable fractions with a host of pursuers in close attendance to the far turn, responded when asked to pick up the pace, repelled a pair of challengers leaving the quarter pole, had something left when set down in the stretch, and went clear under strong handling. FRIDAY NIGHT FEVER raced three-wide, always close to the pace, bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, could not match strides with the winner through the stretch, but kept on gamely to win the battle for the place. SHANGHAI CUPID settled near the back early, came out in upper stretch and rallied six-wide, just missing second. EL CHAVO raced at the rear of the tracking group, always within range of the leader, waited for room through the far turn, then failed to change leads in upper stretch, hung, and was unable to threaten late. BORDERLAND settled well off the pace while saving ground along the rail, moved up heading into the far turn, swung out three wide into the stretch, had some trouble with the lead change, and faltered. ESSENTIAL STORM went four-wide on the clubhouse turn, continued the same path down the backstretch and into the far turn, then was outkicked in the stretch. RAVEN AND OAK showed no early speed from the start despite some coaxing from the rider, dropped to last coming out of the first turn, tried to rally in the stretch but was unable to improve. SPECIAL AGENDA pressed the pace to the outside of MARC to the far turn, gave way near the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.

TIBURON settled near the back, two-wide, made a mild three-wide bid on the far turn and finished with some interest and won a tight battle for second. MOR LANA SPIRIT settled in behind HEAVENVILLE for the first half, moved up approaching the quarter pole in a bid for the lead, but was turned back, kept on, but weakened a bit in deep stretch. ONTHESTAGE was last through the clubhouse turn, settled well off the pace down the backstretch, moved up into contention on the far turn, finished willingly but came up short in a three-way photo for second. QUARTERBACK DAK walked out of the gate, was coaxed early, raced in the middle of the pack, was under a ride midway through the far turn, but did not respond or threaten in the late stages.

MO HOPE got the inside position on the first turn, set a measured pace to the far turn with a pair of rivals pressing the issue to the outside, held sway through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch under steady handling. UPTOWN TAPPIN settled two-wide behind the pace, moved up on the far turn to bid for the lead three-wide at the top of the stretch, finished well, but could not close the gap in the final yards. HASKELLED pressed the pace two-wide, quickened with MO HOPE from the three-rail pole, finished gamely, but was outfinished in the final yards. CLOUDY PAST was hustled into the early mix, pressed the pace three-wide with the front group, came under a ride midway on the turn, and was outfinished. GLOBAL HOLIDAY settled inside with the trailing pair, was close up to the far turn, then unable to keep up in the stretch.

AIR OF GHURAIR got shuffled back at the start, immediately went to the rail, settled in through the first turn, then gradually advanced in the run down the backstretch, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, took over the lead before the stretch, and just held on ahead of a fast closing rival on the outside near the finish. BIG BANG BOOM was two-deep and last into the first turn, settled at the back through the early stages, then produced a strong late bid to just miss. FIFTYSHADESOFNAUTI was forwardly placed from the start, dueled/vied for the lead early on, went on alone through the far turn, dug in under a threat from AIR OF GHURAIR, but could not kick on with that one, kept to task and saved third. TAKE THIS CITY pulled into a forward position early, settled in behind the leading pair to the far turn, made a move to go after the leader leaving the half-mile pole, came into the stretch with every chance but could not sustain the bid in the late stages under steady handling and urging. CRUZIN FOR GURLS got caught three-wide on the first turn, raced at the back of the field through the first half, then mildly improved in the stretch. FAIR WEATHER FLYER lagged in the back half of the field through the early stages, then lacked a finish. WITTS R P M settled in mid-pack along the rail, moved out to the three-path down the backstretch, was asked to go on midway on the turn but did not respond. TEXAS BANDIT contested the early pace from between horses on the first turn, went clear of the rest inside of FIFTYSHADESOFNAUTI down the backstretch, then started to fade on the far turn and was not involved in the stretch. BOONE was hard to load, was being hustled from the gate at the start, shifted out abruptly near the end of the chute, and lost the rider; was caught post-race and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE ACTIONS OF #11 BOONE, AFTER THE START. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN FOLLOWING A VIDEO REVIEW.
