DIAMOND GEM AA dueled up front closest to the inside up the backstretch and through the turn, always traveling well, edged ahead passing the five-sixteenths pole then opened up a clear lead when set down turning into the home stretch and held off a late bid from an outside rival. RB MOTHERLOAD was allowed to settle from the break then tracked three wide down theback stretch and through the turn, started to run on with just under three furlongs to run and produced a grinding finish in the stretch, chase the winner to the wire, but came up short. RB NASH BASH pressed and stalked three wide through the early stages, was being coaxed along to keep up or quicken through the turn, chased the winner to no avail in the stretch and was passed late for the place. AA TAKE A CHANCE tracked inside with the second flight the swung five wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response finishing evenly. DREAM SEQ dueled for early lead to the outside of DIAMOND JIM AA to the turn, was unable to go on with that rival after passing the five-sixteenths marker, then weakened in the stretch. WMA SMOKE SIGNAL devoid of early speed, improved position with some belated interest up the inside while not posing a serious threat. UPTOWN WALK THE LINE raced between horses in the tracking group then weakened and was unable to keep up down the stretch. HONEY PROOF raced close up for a quarter mile then started to drop back through the field and trailed the rest of the way.

HOLIDAY RUN dueled inside of FREEWAY through the early stages then cleared off from the rest together with that rival on the turn, took command in upper stretch and finished well under strong handling while holding the rest at bay to the finish. TAKE MY MONEY tracked the duel on the inside of the tracking trio, saved ground through the turn then finished up well under steady handling but could not get to the winner. RU MOR STARTER allowed to settle from the break, saved all the ground through the turn, then tipped four wide into the stretch and finished well under steady handling to gain third. KEEPMOVINGFORWARD raced between horses with the tracking group and finished willingly under a drive but was not quite good enough. LITTLEJOHNS PRAYER was last away and chased the field into the turn, ran on late and bettered position while not a major threat. FREEWAY dueled to the outside of HOLIDAY RUN to the quarter pole, then weakened and tired in the stretch. SLIM JIMMY was outrun despite being under a drive from the start. ALL MIGHT tracked to the outside of the second flight to the turn, then struggled to keep up halfway through the turn, was kept to task into the stretch then checked near the furlong marker.

JOHNNY APPLESEED settled three to four wide down the backstretch, was being coxed along before the turn but made steady forward progress three to four wide through the turn then kept in a drive down the stretch, finished well and just got up in the final jumps. JUST OKIE tracked just behind the trio contesting the early pace then launched a bid approaching the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch and finished up well under strong handling but lost a heartbreaker in a blanket finish. PRINCE RAMA hustled from the break then vied three wide with PINKY RING BLING and TAKE ACTION to the stretch, was finishing well under a drive then drifted in near the eighth pole, putting the latter foe in a bit tight, then came up short in a crowded photo at the finish. IN THE ARCH lacked speed after the break, tried to launch a bid with about three furlongs to run, was making up some ground as the field bunched up in the final furlong then was stuck behind horses in the late stages. PINKY RING BLING contested the early pace from the inside, dug in down the stretch under strong handling but was out finished in the final yards. TAKE ACTION vied between horses in the three-way speed duel to deep stretch, was battling gamely then steadied slightly near the furlong pole and gave way. COUSIN LARRY was slow into stride without apparent mishap, outrun to the turn, saved ground, but was unable to make an impact.

ACCELERATE JUDY was unruly behind the gate before the start, broke a beat slow then was hustled to be part of the early pace scramble, vied inside to the stretch, then dug in when set down passing the three-sixteenths pole, edged ahead in mid-stretch and held sway to the wire under steady handling and intermittent urging. LADY ZEPHYR came away well and pressed six wide down the backstretch the four wide through the turn, came into the stretch on the wrong lead then straightened out by mid-stretch and was able to gain second. THE NEXT BIG BLING was five the four wide in the early pace battle, rallied to issue a challenge to the eventual winner but was ultimately rebuffed to the wire. TIFF WITH JIMMY broke well and raced three deep in the early pace scramble, held on well into the stretch but lacked a winning kick and came up short for a minor award. LOOKATCHU was always prominent while three to

four wide but could not find another gear when needed in the stretch. ANAJULIAFOREVER race close up on the inside while being ridden to keep pace, appeared reluctant to split horses in the stretch and finished evenly in cover. MAGNOLIA AVENUE attempted to hustle from the break but lacked speed, raced three to four wide with the trailing group through the early stages, ran on some in the stretch but was unable to make an impact. GRAY ZONE was a little slow in stride and then rushed into contention, launched a four wide bid on the turn then went five to six wide into the stretch, finished evenly and lacked a winning kick. RAINBOW SMILES settled on the rail but well off the early pace, was unsuccessfully coaxed to keep up and was outfinished in the stretch. LEONE hustled from the start but was unable to enjoin the early pace, raced four wide at the back of the field through the early stages, remained wide on the turn and into the stretch and failed to threaten. ASTERN MAID was always outrun.

ROMAN EAGLE veered out sharply after the break with the rider doing well to stay aboard, then rushed to join the early pace battle, lost ground on the turn, then found another gear in the stretch and re-bid to gain the third spot. CHEATING HEART got bumped at the start then had to be coaxed to keep up down the backstretch, lost position on the turn, went into full out drive with three furlongs to run and turned in an even effort while lacking a closing bid. FAMOUS TUTT took a light bump from CHEATING HEART at the start then got forward position inside, raced close up to the turn, then began to struggle to keep up passing the five-sixteenths pole and was not a factor in the late stages. HI PLAINS HUNK broke best and gained the early advantage under some pressure, then went to a solo lead into the turn, surrendered the lead turning for home and hand nothing left for the stretch run. HEY COWGIRL tracked mid-pack three wide to the turn then responded when put into a drive from the seven-sixteenths pole, came four to five wide into the stretch with momentum finished well under steady handling and intermittent urging and got up in the final yards. MOON CRATER vied three wide early, then wrested the lead from the others at the top of the stretch, set for home under steady urging went clear of the others but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. LOVE ME SOME CANDY broke in a tangle and spotted a field a couple of lengths head start, then rushed up into contention before the turn, took an inside path through the tuning into the stretch, kept to task, was no threat to the top two but finished well clear of the next horse. CLARISIT broke best then was soon joined by a pair of early challengers to the outside, vied inside through the turn, dug in when challenged in the stretch then gave way grudgingly late. FRANNY contested the early pace between horses early, gave way near the quarter pole and faltered in the stretch. KNOTTY KITTY was rank and hard to place in the early going, was unable to keep up early and raced near the rear of the field down the backstretch, saved ground throughout but could not mount a rally. CHIP ALTERNATIVE lacked early speed, raced well behind early and showed little interest until the stretch and passed a couple in the late stages. MAID TO KEEP tracked mid-pack to the turn, lost some ground then came back on in the stretch but ran out of steam in the final furlong.

BRASS SPUNKY was allowed to settle then tried to launch a four wide rally on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and tired.
