ADGER settled in mid-pack, four-wide early, then advanced three-wide through the far turn, bid for the lead at the three-sixteenths, dueled briefly with BRADIX, gained the upper hand by mid-stretch, and held off a late bid to the outside. KING OF GRACE unhurried early, started to run on after passing the half, advanced through the far turn, came four-wide into the stretch, was gradually closing the gap on ADGER, but ran out of time. BRADIX made the lead into the first turn, led the way in-hand under some mild pressure to the outside from MUCHO MACHO CAM, had something in reserve when called upon at the quarter pole, battled to mid-stretch, then weakened in the late stages. MUCHO MACHO CAM pressed the pace to the outside of BRADIX to the far turn, came under a ride near the three-furlong pole, kept on under a drive but was outfinished. MORO LEGEND was forwardly placed through the clubhouse turn but backed off to a mid-pack tracking position, struggled to keep up on the far turn, and went one-paced through the stretch. HE'S CHARMING steadied in traffic at the seven-eights pole, then raced between horses in the second flight, made a mild forward move on the far turn but was unable to sustain the bid and flattened in the stretch. CAUSE IM THE KING came out from the inside off the first turn, chased late but was unable to make an impact.

GAMBLING DEN sprinted away to a clear early lead, maintained a slight advantage through the turn, turned away the nearest pursuers leaving the quarter pole, and drew off under steady handling. THOUSAND WINS broke slowly, then moved up to track three-wide, moved up through the turn with aim on the leader, was floated a bit wide on the last bend, kept to a steady finish, and moved up to take the second prize. HELLABELLA pressed the pace two-wide, made a try at GAMBLING DEN on the lead near the quarter pole, but could not kick on with that one, kept on through upper stretch, but got passed late and yielded the place. PAYNTER'S PALETTE chased four-wide early, dropped down to the rail through the turn, then could not keep pace in the late stages. HOLIDAY CRUISE was sent hard from the break but steadily dropped back and was outrun.

SHOP TIME settled behind the developing pace battle, raced in last position but always close in the tight field, moved up three to four wide at the quarter pole, pulled clear of the rest with HIGH CINCO and wore down that rival in the final yards to prevail. HIGH CINCO broke sharply, vied for the early pace, then went into the turn pressing the leader two-deep, put a head in front past the quarter pole came into the stretch with a narrow advantage, dueled an outside rival to deep stretch, and was headed in the final yards. RED DIRT ALLEY tracked four-wide but never far back, continued wide through the turn, was on the wrong lead in upper stretch but found a good stride late and moved up to get the minor award. LEXI'S COMEBACK hustled up initially into the early pace mix, then backed off to track close up, weakened under a stiff drive near the quarter pole, and was unable to menace late. WITT'S TEN TOUCH hustled into the early pace mix, came under a ride midway through the turn, and tired in the stretch.

EASY FOR ME stalked SASSY FLYER on the lead to the turn, then dropped back before the three-eighths pole, leaving that rival alone in the lead, came back on in the stretch, took command near the furlong marker, and drew clear to the finish. SCATTERED MISCHIEF settled in mid-pack early, stayed to an inside path to the stretch, and chased the winner to the wire while well clear of the next horse. SASSY FLYER hustled from the break, took command of the race at the half, took a slight lead into the stretch, but failed to change the lead and faltered. HOLIDAY LINES off slow, steadily advanced into contention through the turn, sent around a tiring rival near the quarter pole and finished with mild interest. I'M ON EDGE tracked wide down the backstretch, steadied slightly near the seven-sixteenths, then went evenly late, and was not a threat. DIXIE'S HEART laid off the pace and failed to get involved. FIND THE LIGHT dropped far behind and lacked any response. R S AMERICAN TIDE chased close up along the rail, then came up empty in the stretch.

TURN NORTH settled well off the pace, started to run on approaching the three-furlong pole, came four-wide into the stretch and finished up best of the rest to claim the second prize. GOLDEN GRIT tracked close up behind the leading group, kept on well through the stretch, and just missed second. TX CODE broke on top but was overtaken before going a furlong, lost ground heading into the turn, then found a second wind in the stretch and battled for the minor award. TOO MUCH ACTION contested the early pace two-deep, kicked on approaching the three-furlong pole between rivals, could not go with the winner in the stretch, weakened a bit, then was surrounded and passed by foes in the deep stretch.

VICTORY FOR VETS was close up but five-wide down the backstretch, made a bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, but failed to sustain into the stretch and faltered. MIKEL W pressed the pace four-wide down the backstretch, lost the path going into the turn, steadied slightly, then struggled to regain momentum. TEAM GORMLEY dropped back after the start and never fired. MR JAWS chased from the back and showed little. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
