REGAL RUMOR broke well then tracked four to five wide down the straight, ranged up four wide near the quarter pole to bid for the lead then responded when set down in the stretch, fought a ding-dong battle with DULCIA to the wire and got the bob in the last jump. DULCIA got away well, stalked four wide down the backstretch then three wide though the turn, hooked up with REGAL RUMOR turning for home and battled gamely on the rail but came up on the short end of the photo. CHANGE IT UP got crowded by MY BOY VANDER after the start then raced near the back to the turn, angled out to the four or five path for the stretch run and finished with good energy, closing well under urging but came up a bit short. ARSONIST tracked on the outside of the second group through the early stages then responded when put into a drive approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, advanced three wide through the turn and ran on with some interest down the stretch but could not find a winning kick and was outfinished for a minor award. MILLIE G was briefly up close between horses then dropped off the pace and well behind the rest before going a furlong, launched a rally on the turn while saving all the ground, was still last at the eighth pole but surged under strong handling and almost got there. DAZZLING DUCHESS raced between horses in the second flight, held position to the turn then came under a drive from the five-sixteenths pole but was unable to improve in the stretch. DIAMOND EMPRESS hustled from the break and seized the early lead while being pressed inside by MY BOY VANDER, kicked away passing the three furlong pole then was beset by challengers at the top of the stretch, could not push back and faded in the late stages. MY BOY VANDER came away well and pressed DIAMOND EMPRESS on the lead from the inside, waited until the quarter pole to launch a bid while that rival opened up on the field, loomed as the field turned for home then checked in traffic at the three-sixteenths, lost momentum and could not recover.

NOBLE EAGLE broke inward at the start and bumped KOCHAN, spotted the field a little head start then steadily advanced into contention down the backstretch became boxed in late on the turn then surged to the front at the top of the stretch, lugged in and made solid contact with FINE TUNED in upper stretch, dueled gamely with SOLEVO through the last furlong, kept a nose in front to the wire and prevailed. TOO MUCH ACTION away well, was inside of the three front-runners, turned into the stretch with a slight lead, finished willingly but outkicked in the final yards. OPTIMISTIC COWGIRL was coaxed from the break to get forward position then settled a couple of lengths behind the leaders, held that position to the far turn, then waited patiently while boxed in on the far turn, tipped out to the two path for the stretch run, engaged in a spirited duel with SKY ROCKER down the lane with the pair pulling well clear of the rest, wore down that stubborn foe inside the sixteenth and edged clear at the finish despite drifting out. SKY ROCKER stalked the early pace from the inside the put a head in front heading into the far turn, was being confidently ridden to the top of the stretch, responded when set down and met a challenge posed by OPTiMISTIC COWGIRL, battled that rival gamely the length of the stretch then gave way grudgingly in the final yards. BLUE HEAVENLY unhurried early, kept to the inside while tracking well off the pace through the first half-mile, started an early bid three wide from the seven-sixteenths, came four wide into the stretch and produced a steady finish to win the race for third but well behind the top pair. NO MAS TEQUILA went four wide chasing the lead on the first turn, was being pushed on to stay up with the leaders and loomed near the quarter pole then went flat in upper stretch was not a factor late. BLUSHING BELLE hustled to the front and led the way onto the backstretch, had SKY ROCKER a constant presence to the inside, gave way late on the far turn and had nothing left for the stretch run. BLOOD ORANGE reserved near the rear,

made a mild two wide advance going into the far turn, swung eight wide into the stretch but lacked a rally.
