YACHT ROCK (IRE) broke well and contested the early pace for the initial furlong, backed off a bit heading into the turn while holding the rail, followed TURQUOISE BLUE into the stretch, tipped out to the two path, wore that rival down late and was pulling clear in the end. TURQUOISE BLUE broke well and vied for the lead with several foes in the initial stages, then put a head in front at the half, led the field to the turn with several in close pursuit, edged clear on the turn then met a challenge by YACHT ROCK (IRE) at head of the lane, battled gamely down the stretch then gave way grudgingly in the final yards. GABARRA broke sharply then backed off to a tracking position while staying four to five wide in the clear down the backstretch, advanced three wide through the turn while being coaxed along, then closed under an all-out drive in the stretch to get third. OOHEY GOOEY CHEWY raced close to the pace down the backstretch, then backed off through the turn, kept to the rail in the stretch and finished with good energy under steady handling but came up short. WITT AMERICA got away well then pressed the pace being set by TURQUOISE BLUE through the turn, let that rival slip away passing the five-sixteenths pole, was still with a chance in upper stretch then tired in the late stages. EMBOITE (IRE) lagged in the early stages, was still well behind the main back on the turn then finished with some mild interest while never a serious threat. CINCO MAJESTIC tracked from a few lengths back while three wide lacked a late bid. BIG BRAVE OKIE was outrun from the start and trailed throughout.

AWAKENING vied inside from the break then assumed the lead near the half with MISSY GURL always in close attendance, the pair pulled clear of the rest in the middle of the turn, dueled into the stretch, got the better of the rival by mid-stretch drew off and easily held of a late bid from an outside rival. MATAGORA BAY vied three wide from the start, dropped out of the developing speed duel then re-bid from the five-sixteenths marker and finished up well under steady handling to get the second spot. SISTER HONEY lagged behind the field through the early stages, swung three to four wide into the stretch and rallied into third. MISSY GURL broke well and pressed AWAKENING from the start to the stretch then capitulated in the final furlong and was passed late for a minor award. REBA DEBA chased two wide under a light hold then went in a full drive with three furlongs to run and finished evenly. MISS MAVIS chased from a few lengths back while racing on the inside, struggled to keep up near the five-sixteenths pole and was not a factor in the stretch. TONE OF SILENCE raced four wide and was never a threat.

MAMBRINO chased the pacesetter five wide down the backstretch then three wide through the turn, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run and finished well under strong handling and intermittent urging to prove best. COPPER STORM was bit slow to get going then coaxed into a close tracking position but four to five wide, advanced through the turn while being ridden a little to keep pace, bid for the lead four wide into the stretch and finished with good interest to win the battle for second. BLOCKED made the lead by the five furlong pole without being asked, went a length or more clear through the turn then was beset by a trio of challengers turning into the stretch, responded when set down at the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely but was outfinished in the final yards. BOBWHITE BOBBY settled near the rear of the compact field through the early stages, then tipped out five wide into the stretch and produced a good rally but came up short at the wire. LARIDAE tracked inside close up to the turn, lost some position late on that turn and came up empty for the stretch run. IBERIAN RUNNER tracked between horses close up down the backstretch and into the turn, came under a ride before the quarter pole and did not respond.

GET RIPPED got a good stalking position right behind the pace, was patiently ridden through the turn then tipped out to the two path at the top of the lane, responded when cued to go on, wore down CHARMING OAKIE on the lead and went clear in the end. CHARMING OAKIE showed good speed from the break and got to the front, led the field through the turn, pulled clear with GET RIPPED into the stretch, gave way grudgingly to that foe in mid-stretch and saved the place well clear of the next horse. WILL TAKE CASH rushed up to put pressure on CHARMING OAKIE on the front end and stalked that rival through the turn, came under a ride from the quarter pole, was unable to find a winning kick but was kept to task down the stretch and won the battle for third. BERGHEIM broke out at the start and caused some problems for the runners in the adjacent stalls, then was hustled to join a pair of rivals on the lead, vied inside to the turn then pulled clear in the stretch with TEXAS CREED, staged a spirited duel through the stretch with that rival, gained the advantage inside the sixteenth and just barely held off a fast-closing challenger to the outside. COALCOWBOY was pinched at the start and was last away, settled at the rear and ridden patiently down the backstretch, was still last with three furlongs to run then went eight wide at the top of the stretch and produced a bold rally under steady handling and just missed. RED DIRT RICH tracked behind the two pacesetters and content with that position until late on the turn, launched a bid from the quarter pole, battled an outside rival to the wire while well clear of the next horse but came up short. OPTIMAL COURAGE pressed BANDERA AZTECA from the outside, mounted a challenge from the quarter pole and battled gamely down the stretch under steady urging but was unable to match the top pair in the final yards while saving third. SATURDAY'S GOLD broke well and set for the lead, settled just off the speed duel to the turn, the moved aggressively to bid for the lead, swung three wide

into the stretch then produced a good finish under steady handling, gradually cut in the margin of the leaders down the stretch and was up in the last jump. STAYED IN FOR HALF broke in at the start, then rushed up to duel inside of BLING BLING BLING for the early lead, let that one slip away on the turn then chased that rival into the stretch, gradually cut in the margin, got a head in front late then lost a tough photo to the winner in a super effort. BLING BLING BLING hustled from the break and gained a share of the early lead, tried to quicken away leaving he three furlong marker, came into the stretch with a clear lead, was finishing well under steady handling and intermittent urging then was overtaken in the final yards. CIELO'S KNIGHT settled very wide in the middle of the strung out pack made an eye-catching move three or four wide on the turn and carried the momentum into the stretch was closing rapidly on the leading trio but ran out of time. SIDETOWN raced three wide in the tracking group, broke away and chased the leading trio but was unable to make up any ground while finishing with good energy. BRAHMS BOY broke well but was unable to contest the early pace, went one-paced while saving all the ground. SIGN OF WAR steadied at the break when STAYED IN FOR HALF came over at the start, spotted the field a head start then settled at the rear, saved ground through the turn and made a mild belated rally up the rail. DOSE'S DREAM was slow into stride, settled near the rear swung out into the clear on the turn then five wide into the stretch and finished with some energy while never a threat. HARD CANDY lacked early speed and had only one beaten early on, was last turning for home but kept to task and passed a couple late. PAPA RIZZO raced three wide near the rear of the field and lacked a rally. BOLSHIE broke well and was up close through the early stages, lost interest on the turn and was not a factor late.
