CITY OF SECRETS broke sharply and sprinted clear with the rider doing his best to temper the pace, maintained the margin through the turn while still under confident handling, was let loose leaving the quarter pole, quickly left the rest behind, and sprited away through the stretch with the rider sitting still in the saddle. MORE COFFEE broke well and raced close up in the early stages, took up the chase on the turn, was no match for that rival in the stretch, but kept on well to hold the place. K K'S FIRST DANCE chased close up inside, struggled to keep up the pace on the turn, but kept to task with a steady finish to take the minor award. WILDEST PROBLEM far back early, rallied three-wide into the stretch and gained some ground in the late stages to improve position. CAHILLS REDEMPTION raced well off the pace to the turn, kept to the inside through the turn, but lacked a rally. DOTTIE C chased close up between horses, came under a ride early on the turn and faded in the late stages.
