KERAUNOS stood in the gate as the field was dispatched, spotting the field four or five lengths head start, settled along the rail and was unhurried to the far turn, started to run on from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide into the stretch and produced a bold rally under strong handling and left handed urging to be up in time. BRILLIANT SPIN got squeezed after the break when the horses on either side converged in front, moved to the rail through the first turn, then was inside of the trio tracking the pair up front, went after the lead approaching the quarter pole then bid three wide into the stretch, gained a clear advantage by mid-stretch but was nailed at the wire by the winner. SUMMER LOVER broke inward at the break and put BRILLIANT SPIN in tight quarters, then got forward position and stalked TRANSACTIONAL (GB) just off the flank all the way down the backstretch and into the far turn, put more pressure on approaching the stretch, then briefly had a head in front at the top of the stretch before yielding to an outside rival and was outfinished. TRANSACTIONAL (GB) assumed the early lead without much effort and proceed to take the field through the first half while getting mild pressure from SUMMER LOVER to the outside, dug in when that rival ramped up the pressure on the far turn, responded when set down at the top of the stretch but failed to change leads and weakened. SUPREME LEADER was allowed to settle from the break and not asked for much early, bided time at the back of the tracking group, waited for room on the inside through the turn but was blocked to the stretch then had a mild response once clear. WRINKLE ROAD broke in at the start and took the path from BRILLIANT SPIN, raced three wide with the tracking group, finished with mild late interest but was not a serious threat. BIG COMMERCE raced two deep between horses in the second flight, came under a ride on the far turn held position to mid-stretch then was outfinished.

TEXAS RED BEL hustled from the break and gained the lead with STORMY BISONETTE shadowing to the outside, was traveling well through the turn then opened up when set down at the three-sixteenths and powered away to an easy win. EAGLE EXPRESS was pushed to get forward position but unable to contest the early pace, remained inside in the tracking position while having to be ridden some to keep pace, got a clean run inside through the turn and into the stretch was no match for the winner then battled NATURAL TOUCH for the second spot and was able to keep that rival at bay. NATURAL TOUCH was close up behind the pace between horses down the backstretch then became boxed in through the turn, found a seam at the top of the stretch, had some trouble changing leads while battling with EAGLE EXPRESS for the place but could not get past while well clear of the rest. ITS MY MONEY TOO settled after the break and was well behind the pace early while racing, advanced steadily down the backstretch and through the turn, bid six wide into the stretch, finished willingly but was not quite good enough to threaten. SHARP LIKENESS got a stalking position behind the leading pair, bid four wide for the lead passing the quarter pole then flattened out. STORMY BISONETTE was lapped on the pacesetter from the start, gave way at the quarter pole and faltered in the stretch. MOLA MIA chased the tracking group while saving ground but was unable to improve. MAYAPRETTY broke well but lacked any early speed, dropped far behind down the backstretch then was kept to task and managed to pass one near the finish. HAP HOT broke inward after the start and put BALSA in tight, then raced just off the flank of JACKMAN'S RIDE, content to let that foe lead the way through the turn, ranged up approaching the quarter pole, found a resurgent foe, did battle for the length of the stretch, got a head in front passing the sixteenth pole and prevailed while setting a new track record for the distance. JACKMAN'S RIDE was hustled to the front with HAP HOT always in close pursuit, led the field to the quarter pole, fought back when challenged by HAP HOT at the top of the stretch then was overtaken inside the sixteenth in a stellar effort. DESERT GLOW pressed FELLA'S SISTER through moderate fractions from the first turn to the last bend, could not match strides with that rival in the stretch and lost the place in the final yards. WILBURNSCLASSYLADY broke a step slow and was roused to keep up with the early pace then was two to three wide just a length or two behind the pace as the field was bunched up for much of the contest, launched a four wide bid on the far turn, loomed approaching the quarter pole then came under pressure and went a bit flat in the stretch. SAN MATEO KAT was last but close to the front in the tightly bunched field, started to lose ground on the far turn and was not a factor from that point.

KUPUNA lacked speed and settled near the rear in the early going while being coaxed along to keep contact with the field, circled the field four wide on the turn then finished well under steady handling despite racing on the wrong lead for much of the stretch run. HALMSTAD broke best then ceded the lead to SIR STIRLING while keeping constant pressure on that foe through the turn, took command passing the quarter pole then battled back an early challenge from TODDCHERO, bested that foe but was no match for the winner in the late stages. TODDCHERO tracked four wide early, ranged up three wide approaching the quarter pole, was finishing well under steady handling but could not catch the top pair in the stretch. ESTABLISHED off a bit slowly, was put into a drive from the start, steadied slightly at the seven-sixteenths pole, was kept to task into the stretch and was slowly gaining ground while not a serious threat. BIG BERNIE outrun early, responded when put into a drive with three furlongs to run, swung three wide into the stretch and bettered position while not a major threat. SIR STERLING broke a step slow then was hustled forward to take the lead, was under constant pressure from HALMSTAD through the turn, gave way to that foe in upper stretch and tired. KENTUCKY DAWN was up close to the pace through the initial stages then began to struggle to keep up approaching the half mile pole, came four wide into the stretch and finished one-paced. GENERAL SHIPMAN tracked between horses just behind the pace, loomed approaching the quarter pole then faltered and was put into a protective hold and not persevered with in the stretch.

MOON CAT got away well and was sent forward to bid for the early lead, was content to sit just to the outside of COASTAL BRINK down the backstretch with another rival just to the outside and the rest in close pursuit, vied between horses on the far turn, out a head in front passing the quarter pole then was overtaken by the eventual winner in upper stretch, finished gamely under strong handling and intermittent urging and just saved the place from a fast closing inside rival. BAREFOOT SAMURAI raced up close but boxed in for most of the early running, waited for room on the turn the was spinning wheels when clear in upper stretch, responded late to steady urging and surged late and just missed second. DOMINANT SPIRIT lunged at the start, spotting the field a bit of a head start, then went four wide through the clubhouse turn, settled last, three to four wide near the rear of a very compact field, chased through the turn then finished with some belated interest while not posing a serious threat. EXCAPING THE BLUES hopped in the air at the start then rushed up to vie for the early lead, went four wide through the first turn, stalked three wide down the backstretch, was unable to go on when the pace quickened from the quarter pole, came under strong handling and urging, came back on a bit but could not threaten. COASTAL BRINK was guided to the front from the break, emerged from the first turn with the lead heading down the backstretch, set a modest pace with the rest in close pursuit, maintained the lead into the turn then resisted when challenged near the five-sixteenths pole, led into upper stretch but could not summon a winning finish once clear. UPTOWN TAPPIN saved ground throughout, was always close up, lacked room and steadied mid-stretch and could not recover.

GOING TO SANANTONE broke well and was hustled to the front, opened up on the field before the half, turned back a challenge from DUSTINS DENILE near the quarter pole then held sway down the stretch to prevail. DUSTINS DENILE broke well, dueled with REDFORTYSEVEN for the second spot behind the runaway leader, moved away from that one to challenge for the lead near the quarter pole but was rebuffed, kept chasing the eventual winner to the wire and finished well clear of the third horse. FLY RED BIRD FLY was off a bit slowly but advanced steadily into contention down the backstretch, got clear run three wide through the turn, lugged in briefly at the top of the stretch then finished well under left handed urging to grab the third spot. SIPPIN SCOTCH allowed to settle from the break, was near the back of the field through the early stages racing two to three wide, came about four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to improve while never a serious threat. GOLDEN PURSUIT raced four wide throughout and finished evenly under steady urging. CHASING THE RUSH veered out after the break, bothering OKLAHOMA FLAME, then raced at the front of the tracking group to the turn, got an inside run through the turn, and finished evenly. MIDNIGHT TWISTER ducked in towards the gap after the start and was last away, then roused to get back in contact with the field, was the trailer to the turn and passed tiring rivals in the lane. GUS CAUSE raced mid-pack on the rail through the early stages, was being ridden passing the seven-sixteenths pole and making no progress, took the inside route into the stretch and was kept to task under intermittent urging to the finish. OKLAHOMA FLAME steadied after the start to avoid CHASING THE RUSH, made a mild middle move but could not sustain and faded. REDFORTYSEVEN broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter in tandem with DUSTINS DENILE to the outside, weakened before the quarter pole and tired in the stretch. TEXANO HERO failed to menace while racing two wide. XANDER S tracked mid-pac
