RB BOYFRYND broke well then pulled he rider into the early pace mix, took the lead passing the half then repelled a challenge approaching the quarter pole, responded when asked to go on and held sway to the wire. DREAM SEQ was forwardly placed but four wide in the early going, moved together with TM PURNCESS to challenge for the lead but proved no match, chased the winner home well clear of the third horse. TM PURNCESS was last into stride then tracked a few lengths behind the pace battle, started a four wide forward move three wide on the turn, and finished up well to claim third while never a serous threat. HONEY PROOF broke well and vied for the early lead between horses, was unable to keep up after passing the half and was not a factor in the late stages. WMA ATLAS outrun early, fell behind and trailed throughout. JAGMAN AA broke well and was one of four contesting the early pace, was overtaken before the turn and had little to offer from that point.

MIGHTY ENTICING got away well and raced close up three wide to the half mile pole being coaxed along, launched a bid leaving the three furlong marker and went to challenge SCHOOL TEACHER for the lead, found that foe tough to get by at the head of the stretch, gained an advantage in mid-stretch and drew clear in the end. SCHOOL TEACHER broke well but conceded the lead to SHERRYS RIDGE, settled along the rail in the close tracking position, took over the lead leaving the half, went clear on the far turn with MIGHTY ENTICING in close pursuit to the outside, matched the bid in upper stretch then gave way grudgingly passing the furlong pole and held second. WILD STEEL got caught four wide through the first turn then remained wide while tracking the pace on the outside of the second flight, launched a three wide bid from the three furlong marker, chased the top pair down the stretch to no avail but finished well clear of the next horse. SHERRYS RIDGE made the lead on the first turn then went clear down the backstretch until being overtaken at the halfway point, was unable to keep up and finished evenly the rest of the trip. FUN AS ALL GIT OUT was close up on the inside for most of the race, was unable to on when the leaders got away at the top of the stretch and was one-paced the rest of he way. MISS MOTOR MOUTH was outrun through the early stages, later settling to the outside of fellow trailer MADDIE'S MAVERICK, tried to launch a bit on the far turn and made up some ground in the stretch but was unable to threaten. MADDIE'S MAVERICK lacked any speed, raced well behind the rest to the inside of MISS MOTOR MOUTH, got left behind on the far turn and finished far back.

HONEST broke well then took up an inside stalking position a couple of lengths behind the developing pace battle, got a clean run through the turn and went forward near the five-sixteenths to put pressure on MIDSHIPMAN'S LADY, dueled that stubborn foe into the stretch, went head-to-head to deep stretch then edged clear in the final yards. MIDSHIPMAN'S LADY showed good speed from the break and made the lead without really being asked, led the way through the turn then fought back when challenged by HONEST at the five-sixteenths pole, battled gamely to deep stretch but was outfinished in the shadow of the wire. AVALING was unable to contest the early pace but was allowed to settle into stride, made steady forward progress down the backstretch and through the turn then bid five wide into the stretch finished with good energy despite having some trouble changing leads and gained the third spot. GOD KNOWS WHY was pinched at the start then was far back through the early stages, saved ground, made a sustained run from the three furlong pole, got within striking distance by mid-stretch and was mildly gaining in the end. BLING BABY chased well behind the main to the turn, responded when put into a drive, was making up ground along the rail then flattened out. ALL AMERICAN LADY tracked close up four to five wide came five wide into the stretch and lacked a finish. SASSY FLYER was close up between horses to the turn, then dropped out of it at the quarter pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch. GEE SHE'S FANCY dropped far behind early and was never a factor.

MALIBU S S settled five wide in the middle of the pack, circled the field on the turn, loomed five wide at the top of the stretch then produced a strong rally under steady handling and was along in time. BIG MUCKITY broke well and vied on the outside of a trio contesting the early pace, was between four horses





contesting the lead at the top of the stretch, dueled NIGHTWIND to the wire, bested that one late but could not hold the winner at bay. NIGHTWIND was first to the front then soon joined by BIG MUCKITY and HARD GOLD, cut the corner and responded when set down, had a short lead at the furlong pole, was game to the wire but outfinished in the final yards. LEVY was outrun from the break then pushed early to get closer while keeping to the inside path, moved out a path on the turn to launch a bid from the five-sixteenths pole, finished with good interest. HARD GOLD was between horses battling for the early lead, held position through the turn then battled on to mid-stretch then weakened late. MACHO GRANDE lagged behind the main pack to the turn, rallied much too late but improved position in the stretch. WILL THE THRILL came away well and settled just behind the trio contesting the pace while holding the rail, got boxed in through the turn and into the stretch but lacked a rally when clear late. R D C POSSE came away well from the outside post and got a stalking position behind the trio setting the early tempo, launched a bid for the gate, lagged at the back of the field, saved ground through the turn and was able to pass a few stragglers in the stretch. TEXAS TITAN raced five to six wide early, continued wide through the turn and was not a factor in the late stages. UNION DATA was being ridden to keep up while racing in the middle of the pack, struggled to keep pace on the turn the dropped back and was wrapped up late when hopelessly behind.

CATALYST settled mid-pack then moved closer down the backstretch, bided time through the turn, slipped through an opening along the rail into the stretch, gained the lead in the final furlong and went clear late. WANDERING KIRBY seized the early lead and dictated a moderate pace, carried that slight lead into the stretch, was confronted by CATALYST in upper stretch, gave way readily while able to save the place. SUGARCOAT lagged near the rear through the first half then rallied in the stretch to gain the third spot. SUMMERTIMEE stalked WANDERING KIRBY for the first half mile, gave way late on the turn and tired in the stretch. MY SWEET LOVE tracked the pacesetters to the turn then lacked a finish. TIZ A KNOCKOUT lagged at the back of the field to the turn then started to run on with about three furlongs to go and passed a few late. RAZORS EDGE was briefly close then dropped back and was not involved in the final outcome. WONDER WAVE (IRE) was mid-pack to the half then steadily retreated the rest of the trip.
