NO TROUBLE tracked to the outside of PINEHURST (IRE) several lengths behind the pacesetters for the first half-mile, moved closer through the far turn, the launched a three to four wide bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, took a short lead in upper stretch, beat back a challenger from NERKY ROSE in the stretch and held sway to the wire under strong handling. NERKY ROSE settled near the rear five wide early on then three wide on the far turn, started a forward run with about three furlongs to run came four to five wide into the stretch and dueled with NO TROUBLE through the last furlong, had every chance but could not get by that rival. 

CITY GHOST was hustled away from the gate and gained a slight lead by the half-mile pole, led the field into the stretch and was taken on to the outside by BENDELENE, fought on under strong handling and kept that runner at bay to the wire in a stellar effort. BENDELENE was away well and tracked close three wide to the turn, ranged up late on the turn to bid for the lead, responded when set down in upper stretch, battled relentlessly with CITY GHOST for the length of the stretch but could not get by. NAVAL WOMAN veered in at the break, causing a chain reaction to the inside recovered well enough to reach contention by the head of the turn, bid for the lead at the quarter pole, had to deal with a stubborn MY BOY VANDER for most of the stretch then edged clear late. MY BOY VANDER easily sized the early lead, was left alone to dictate he pace, with a pair of rivals pressing the issue to the outside, fought back when confronted by NAVAL WOMAN at the top of the stretch but gave way late while saving the place. TAPIT FIRST tracked four wide through the early stages, bid for the lead between horses passing the quarter pole, then produced a four wide late rally in the stretch to improve. SECURED was always prominent near the indie rail, rallied willingly up the rail in the stretch but was just not good enough for these. DUTTON STREET GIRL shuffled back at the start and was last away, continued to trail through the turn then rallied mildly to improve. OK BY ME raced mid-pack through the early running, struggled to keep up on the far turn then re-rallied but was never a threat. DIAMOND EMPRESS pressed/stalked pace early, went into a drive from the five-sixteenths pole and lacked a rally. LITTLE IRIS outrun through the early stages, went into a drive before the half and passed a few in the late stages. FLASH MASTER steadied at the start and was last away, moved forwardly down the backstretch and through the turn, then went one-paced in the stretch. ITTY BABY raced close up five wide into the turn, came under pressure after passing the three furlong marker and shrugged to keep up late. COMPETITIVE BOND ducked in after the start and lost the rider, was caught and walked off.

GEOMETRIQUE settled near the rear of the main back through the first half mile, launched a three wide bid on the last turn, tipped out to the four path for the stretch run and proceed a good rally under steady urging and was able to get up for second. QUEEN OF SALSA tracked two deep behind the pace, made an early bid from the five-sixteenths, came under heavy pressure near the quarter pole, finished well under strong handling but was outfinished in the late stages. CONTOUR pressed and dueled with SUPER LUXE through moderate fractions, took command after passing the five -sixteenths pole, had some trouble eight the lead change in the stretch and was passed late. DEVILETTA settled mid-pack then finished with some mild interest while never a serious threat. CLAIRE JUNE broke outward at the start and bothered SHOW ME THE CANDY, tracked inside just behind the dueling leaders to the turn, bided time t through the far turn while behind horses, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run and flattened out. SHOW ME THE CANDY shuffled back when CLAIRE JUNE took the path at the start, angled over to the inside and was taken back to last, dropped far behind and made mild belated rally in the stretch. SUPER LUXE dueled contour through moderate fractions, gave way near the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.
