GIRL FROM DE BAYOU broke well, took the lead passing the five-furlong pole, led the way while getting some pressure from HOT PINK, slipped away from the rest late on the turn, and outsprinted the field to the wire in a stellar effort. MILLIE G off a step slow, settled inside just behind the pace, came under a ride on the turn and chased the winner home while clear of the rest. SAY AS I SAY broke on top but retreated to the back on the backstretch run, launched a three-wide bid on the turn, swung six-wide into the stretch, had some trouble with the lead change in upper stretch, but got straightened out in mid-stretch and moved up to take the third prize. THAT'S THE DEAL tracked between rivals to the stretch, finished evenly under a drive. MISS MAVIS lacked early speed, raced on the inside, and churned on willingly through the stretch while never posing a threat. HOT PINK pressed the pace two-wide through the first quarter mile, then weakened late on the turn and lacked a late response. HOT ROUTE was a little slow to begin, raced in mid-pack between rivals but backed up late on the turn and had nothing to offer in the stretch..
