QUIXX flew from the gate and seized the early lead, was joined by JAWDROPPER going into the turn, dueled inside of that rival through the turn, then went clear into the stretch and held off a challenge by CLARISIT to prevail. CLARISIT gave chase behind the dueling leaders along the inside, made a late try at QUIXX through the stretch, but had to settle for second well clear of the next finisher. JAWDROPPER broke well, dueled outside of QUIXX through the turn, gave way passing the quarter pole, but kept on to save third. LAST PICK was being coaxed along while tracking between horses in the second flight, then kept on mildly through the stretch. WITT'S GONE WEST was a little slow to get going, advanced down the backstretch under a drive, came three-wide into the stretch, but lacked a finish. SAKURAS was outpaced from the start, chased under a ride through the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, but failed to menace. BELLE ROUGE dropped back early and was never involved.
