Supplemental nominations in the amount of \$2,000 may be made at time of entry and shall include all fees. Purse includes \$60,000 from the TTA Event Fund. The Purse to be divided: \$1,000 to all starters sixth through last. The remaining Purse to be distributed: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2025 - 2026 allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of two races since September 23, 2025 allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in weight allowances). Preference to horses with highest earnings in 2025-2026 at time of entry. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. MODO sent hard to seize the early lead, maintained a clear advantage through the turn, then drew off powerfully in the stretch without being asked. TOO MUCH KIKI settled well off the early pace, came off the rail to bid three-wide through the turn, and finished up well to gain the place while never a threat to the winner. NAVAL WOMAN raced close up three-wide down the backstretch, gave futile chase through the turn, she was outfinished for second while finishing well clear of the next horse. RECLUSIVE was four-wide near the back in the early going, began a mild bid still wide through the turn, had a little trouble with the lead change at the top of the stretch, and flattened out in upper stretch. GLEE was outrun early despite the urgings of the rider from the start, trailed the field into the turn, kept to the inside to the stretch, and improved. SUCCESSFULPATH raced well back off the pace up three-wide up the backstretch, continued around the turn, but made no bid. BLUSHING BELLE tracked in range up the backstretch, lost ground late on the turn, and failed to menace. OOH LA DA STOOPS chased the pacesetter up the rail, weakened before the three-furlong pole, then had nothing left in the stretch.
