HURTS SO GOOD was on the pace out from the rail, edged clear into the lane but could not hold the winner late. TIMEHASCOME stalked two or three wide, moved four wide into the lane and gained but could not reach the top pair. SIS BOOM BOB prompted the pace outside a rival and came up empty in the drive. TOUGH AS AN OX trailed.
