FEBRUARY away well and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear advantage in the run down the backside, maintained her clear advantage through the final turn, and was never seriously threatened late. BLUEBIRD CAFE tracked the leader into the first turn while racing one out from the rail, held a stalking trip behind a lone pacesetter in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide through the final turn, and finished one out from the rail in the drive to get up for the place. DUKE GIRLS broke sharply and stalked the pacesetter into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, commenced her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, and closed determinedly from along the rail in the drive to garner a share. STILETTOS ONLY away alertly and stalked the leader into the backside while racing one out from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed evenly two out from the rail in the drive. EBONY EYES settled at the back of the pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact when called upon.
