CHI CHI TIME away well and dueled for the lead from the outside of SOMEDAY LADY entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue two wide in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn and quickly assumed command, opened a clear advantage through the turn, and continued to widen her margin late while under confident handling to prove too good. ZENARI away alertly and settled off the dueling leaders into the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, bided her time well off the pacesetter in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly from along the inside in the drive to get up for the place in the closing strides. SOMEDAY LADY broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, continued to set a pressured pace from the inside of CHI CHI TIME in the run down the backside,, was unable to match strides with that rival entering the final turn, and just failed to hold the place, while clearly best of the rest. SAILING FORCE settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, began to advance soon after entering the backside, launched her bid three wide entering the final turn, but hung in he lane while finishing two out from the rail. DONNA WYN tracked the leaders through the stretch the first time while saving ground along the inside, dropped back in the run down the backside, rallied four wide through the final turn, and improved her position late while unable to threaten. COMMANDS ATTENTION unhurried early while dropping back to trail, continued to bide her time at the back of the pack in the run down the backside, commenced her bid from along the rail entering the final turn, and finished two wide in the drive while unable to mount a serious late bid. WHY NOTS A WYNNER tracked the leaders through the stretch the first time while racing three wide under snug restraint, continued to pull her away along from a tracking trip in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide into the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong.
