DREAMB away well, but was content to settle off the early pace while racing one out from the rail, while trailing the filed into the backstretch, launched her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, and closed gamely while splitting rivals late to get up in time. HIGHER IMAGE stalked the leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, awaited room briefly while saving ground in the run to the final turn, rallied smartly from along the inside entering the final turn, and closed determinedly two out from the rail in the drive to just miss. WHY NOTS A WYNNER broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, assumed a clear advantage entering the final turn, maintained that lead into the lane, and just failed to last. BRODYS SOUVENIR away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of WHY NOTS A WYNNER entering the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backside, was unable to match strides with her pace rival entering the final turn, and was outfinished over the final furlong. MISS SUNDAZE hopped at the start to get away slowly, and raced into a stalking trip two out from the rail entering the backstretch, continued with a four wide trip in the run down the backside and into the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response late when called upon. JUST SCARLETT tracked the dueling leaders through the first turn while racing one out from the rail, held her position in the run down the backstretch, but weakened over the final furlong.
