VALERIE VALESKI away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the backstretch, controlled the pace in the run down the backside, maintained her advantage while continuing to save ground through the final turn, and held PETERSON LANDING safely at bay late to prove best. PETERSON LANDING tracked the leaders from along the rail entering the backstretch, launched her bid two wide entering the final turn, and finished willingly one out from the rail in the drive to prove second best. B C CHRISTIE settled at the back of the pack while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, advanced smartly from along the rail midway down the backside to gain a striking position entering the final turn, rallied along the inside through the turn, and closed two wide in the drive to garner a share. DONE THAT tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied two wide into the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. CERTIFIABLE broke sharply, and settled off the early pace while racing three wide into the first turn, continued with a wide trip down the backside, and was through before reaching the final turn.
