ROSE OF TEXAS broke sharply and stalked the leaders into the stretch while racing two out from the rail, maintained her position through the second turn and into the backstretch, launched her bid three wide entering the final turn and took a narrow advantage into the lane, and inched clear late to prove best. PRINCESS ALESKA raced to the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, dictated the pace through the second turn and in the run down the backside, maintained her lead into the final turn, was collared leaving the turn, and inched clear late while finishing three wide in the drive. FOOTHILLS BLVD. away well, and was allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the stretch the first time, held her position into the backstretch, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, and finished from along the rail in the drive to garner a share. PINEAPPLE TIDBITS settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, bided her time at the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and finished three wide in the drive while unable to mount a serious late threat. DON'TPASSTHEPEPPER away alertly, and tracked the leader through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, chased that rival in the run down the backside and into the final turn, and weakened over the final furlong.
