STANFORD BAY away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace in the run down the backstretch from the inside of SOARINGFORTHESUN, continued to battle with that rival into the final turn, got the better of that foe leaving the turn and quickly opened a clear advantage, and held off a late surge by SET TO SHINE to prevail. SET TO SHINE tracked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied smartly three wide entering the final turn, and closed full of run four wide in the drive to just miss. COUNTERACT stalked the contested early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, commenced her bid two wide entering the final turn, and finished willingly two wide in the drive to get up for a share. SOARINGFORTHESUN broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the outside of STANFORD BAY entering the first time, continued to force the issue two wide in the run down the backside and into the final turn, was unable to match strides with his pace rival leaving the turn, and was outfinished late. EVANDERKEEN stalked the early pace from the back of a compact filed while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, commenced his bid from along the rail entering the final turn, but needed more when called upon.
